**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE ACCEPTANCE OF A \$21,053.99 E-BIKE
PURCHASE GRANT FROM THE FIREHOUSE SUBS PUBLIC SAFETY
FOUNDATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF 4 RECON E-BIKES**

WHEREAS, City of West Allis Policy P510 requires the West Allis Common Council to approve the acceptance of all grant awards; and

WHEREAS, the West Allis Police Department has specially trained officers who use traditional bicycles to effectively patrol at community events such as the Wisconsin State Fair, and bicycles have proven beneficial in allowing officers to quickly respond to incidents in areas experiencing heavy vehicle traffic; and

WHEREAS, police bicycle programs have proven to be an excellent community engagement tool, and the use of electric bicycles will allow officers to cover more ground without experiencing fatigue; and

WHEREAS, the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation provides grants to first responder agencies designed to provide first responders with needed equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation has approved a \$21,053.99 grant request from the West Allis Police Department to purchase 4 Recon E-Bikes; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds are immediately available and do not require a local match;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the City accepts the \$21,053.99 grant award from the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation for the purchase 4 Recon E-Bikes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, City Administrator, and Chief of Police are authorized to take all necessary actions to execute and administer the grant agreement, and to allocate said funds in accordance with the terms of the grant.

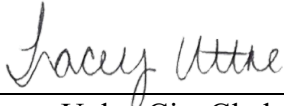

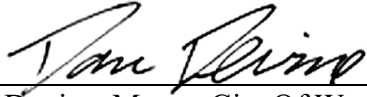
