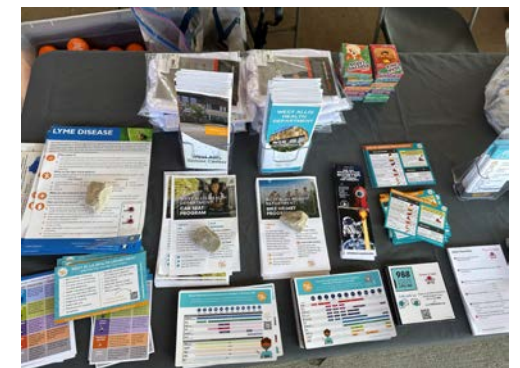


SOUTHWEST SUBURBAN HEALTH DEPARTMENT (SWSHD) SUMMER IN REVIEW (JUNE-AUG)

- 2,053 Vital Records
 - 547 birth certificates
 - 1,506 death certificates
- 17 community events with over 500 participants/attendees
- 2,103 WIC Families and 3,182 Participants
- 2 new bus shelter adds for DV Awareness, 2 suicide prevention billboards, 3 gas station Narcan signs & a commercial recorded for opioid abuse prevention
- 100+ individuals trained in Narcan
- 18 immunization and TB clinics, with 102 clients
- 15 blood pressure clinics
- ~650 Environmental Inspections
- 54 car seats checked and distributed

CLINICAL SERVICES

JUNE- AUGUST 2024

Greenfield

- TB Skin Tests- *23 placed and read*
- Immunizations- *14 people served*
- Blood Pressures- *26 appointments* not including the senior living facilities
 - Blood pressure clinics at 4 Senior Living facilities once a month (~25 people)
- Immunization and TB Skin Test clinics two times per month
- 3+ safe sleep appointments

West Allis

- TB Skin Tests- *51 placed and read*
- Immunizations- *16 people served*
- Blood Pressures- *1 appointment* plus Senior Center BPs once per month (~10 people)
- Immunization and TB Skin Test clinics six times per month

WIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES JUNE-AUGUST 2024

WIC

- WIC served an average of *1575 families and 2367 participants* from June-August at the West Allis location.
- WIC served an average of *528 families and 815 participants* at the Greenfield location

Environmental (Greenfield location)

- Routine Inspections (57)
 - 9 grocery/gas stations
 - 17 restaurants, 28 Pools
 - 1 Lodging, 2 Body Art
- Re-Inspections (19)
- Pre-Licensing Inspections (9)

Environmental (West Allis / West Milwaukee)

- Routine Inspections (50)
 - 13 grocery/gas stations
 - 15 restaurants, 10 Pools
 - 11 Lodging, 0 Body Art
- Re-Inspections (15)
- Pre-Licensing Inspections (29)
