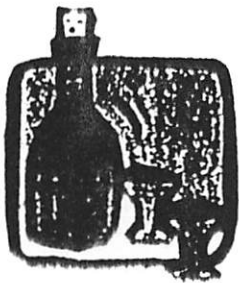

**Wine Sampling on "Class A" Premises.**  
The budget allows "Class A" liquor li-  
censees to provide free wine taste sam-



ples, between the  
hours of 10 A.M. and  
6 P.M., of not more  
than 3 fluid ounces  
each to customers and  
visitors for on-premis-  
es consumption.

Under the budget, no  
"Class A" licensee  
can provide: (1) more

than two taste samples per day to any one  
person; and (2) provide taste samples to  
any underage person. The budget also  
provides that municipalities can prohibit  
wine sampling on "Class A" premises.


