RE: Downtown BID Sidewalk Sale - July 23, 2004

Dear Honorable Mayor Bell and Common Council:

The Promotions Committee for the *Downtown West Allis Business Improvement District* is developing plans to repeat a West Allis tradition – a sidewalk sale in the downtown, called "Downtown Race Day." The Committee has selected the date of Friday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2004, in partnership with the Milwaukee Mile's IRL Race Weekend. The event will run from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM, rain or shine, drawing people to Downtown West Allis prior to the IRL parade that evening.

This letter is a request from the Business Improvement District to restrict parking along Greenfield Avenue from 70<sup>th</sup> to 76<sup>th</sup> Streets, as has been done in the past with the Classic Car Show and other sidewalk sales. In order to accommodate the event, we are asking to close 71<sup>st</sup> Street (south and north to the alley), 72<sup>nd</sup> Street (south and north to the alley), and 73<sup>rd</sup> Street (south and north to the alley). The above closed streets will provide space for vendors, entertainment and community groups.

With the approval of the Common Council, the BID will make the necessary arrangements with Mike Pertmer and the Public Works Department for signs and barricades. Prior to the event, the BID will provide a \$1 million certificate of insurance listing the City of West Allis as an additional insured.
