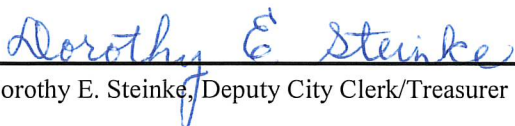
WHEREAS, The Common Council deems it to be in the best interests of the City of West Allis that the proposal of Graybar Electric Co., Inc. be accepted.
