The following is a summary of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service during the month of June.

Incident reports:

Case # 13-004864, 06/02/2013, at 0148 hrs – 1100 S. 60 St, Double Barrel & 1101 S. 60 St., Bulldog 60.

On 06/02/2013 at 0148 hrs., Officers responded to 1100 S. 60 St, Double Barrel for a report of a trouble call. Andrew Lomax stated he was standing outside of his tavern when Hsiu Yu Zen, went across the street with an alcoholic drink and threw it at Lomax. Police made contact with Zen at Bulldog 60, and he admitted to the incident on scene. He was arrested for Disorderly conduct, given a local citation and released from the substation after being booked.

Case # 13-005101, 06/09/2013, at 0135 hrs - 7527, W. Becher St. Flappers

On 06/09/2013, Officer observed a female shouting and swearing at another male outside of Flappers, 7527 W. Becher St. There was a crowd of people outside the bar. The officer approached the bar and spoke the female, Leah B. Janke. While speaking with Leah, a male party, identified as Nicholas Damato, continually interrupted the Officer's investigation saying, "Nothing happened". Nicholas was told several times to step away, but refused. He was subsequently arrested for Hindering. It was later determined that Leah had threatened a male outside of the bar. She was subsequently arrested for Disorderly Conduct. Both parties were transported to the stated, booked, cited and released.

Case #13-006086, 06/09/2013, at 2345 hrs - 6827 W. National Av, GR's National Pub

On 06/09/2013, at approximately 2345 hrs., Officers responded to 6827 W. National Av, GR's National Pub, for 2 male Hispanics causing a problem. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with the caller, Sarah Denoble. Sarah is a bartender at GR's, however, for this incident she was a patron who called the police. She stated 2 male Hispanics, had been causing problems inside the bar and refused to leave. Prior to leaving the bar, one of the males made reference to a drug cartel and made a gun with his hands. These two parties, later identified as Joel B. Beltran-Coyolt and Jesus NMI Mazaba-Campechano, were later located at the Dog House. Officers responded back to the GR's Pub and the bartender advised they did not want them arrested, but just to stay away from the establishment. Both parties were highly intoxicated and did not understand English. Parties were advised to not return to GR's or they would be arrested.

Case #13-005540, 06/23/2013, at 0204 hrs – 9105 W. Lincoln Av. Draft Bar

On 06/23/2013, at 0204 hrs., an Officer was traveling on W. Lincoln Av when he observed two parties fighting on the grass outside of the Draft Bar. Daniel Casarez, Kondwani Harleaux and Bryan Kainz were actively involved in a fight. All three parties were arrested for Disorderly Conduct, book and released, except for Daniel, who had a Probation/Parole hold placed on him.

Case # 13-005582, on 06/24/2013, at 0158 hrs – 1901 S. 60 St, Las Palmas

On 06/24/2013, at approximately 0158 hrs, Officers were nearby 1901 S. 60 St, Las Palmas, for shots being fired outside of the business. Edy Matute resisted officers on scene and was eventually placed into custody. Noel Monge, Luis Carlos Ruiz Navarro, and Juan Sanchez, were all arrested and given local citations for Disorderly Conduct for their involvement in the physical fight outside of the business. A handgun was located in the parking lot of Burnham Bowl. Handgun casings fired from the weapon were located in front of Las Palmas on the opposite side of the street. Adrian Sanchez admitted to firing the weapon several times on scene. Sanchez was booked for Reckless Endangerment of Safety. Matute was booked for Disorderly Conduct, Resisting an Officer and Bail jumping. DA reviewed the case on 06/25/2013. Local citations are set for 07/29/13.

Carlos Cruz, current security officer at Las Palmas, stated he was working inside of the business when he began to observe a verbal argument taking place outside of the business. Cruz stated he removed his baton from his belt and began to use it in an attempt to separate males from physically fighting. When the altercation began to turn physical, Cruz removed the pepper spray from his holster and began to spray several individuals that were actively fighting with other parties.

Cruz then observed a male in the area hold a firearm and fire the weapon, with the muzzle facing towards the sky. Cruz yelled for the man to drop his weapon. Cruz stated the individuals involved in the incident were regular bar patrons of the business.

Case # 13-005576, on 06/23/2013, at 2344 hrs - 7411 W. Becher St, Barneck's.

On 06/23/2013 at approximately 2344 hrs., Officers responded to Barnecks, 7411 W. Becher St for a report of people fighting in the bar. Aaron Dolinski was in the bar with his mother, Eva Videkovich. Eva and Brian began yelling back and forth at each other because Eva was playing video poker. Aaron stepped in and stated "Don't talk to her like that". Brian and Eva got into a physical altercation. When Aaron stepped in to break the fight up, Brian grabbed him and held him to the ground. The bartender, Michelle Alexander, called the police.

Case #13-005801, on 06/30/2013, at 2238 hrs., - Mugshotz Bar.

On 06/30/2013, at 2238 hrs., Officers responded to Mugshotz Bar, 1902 S. 68 St, for a report of a man with a gun. Investigation revealed Robert S. Oleszek entered Mugshotz, with a handgun in his right hand, with his finger on the trigger, and demanded to know where his wife was. Jason Schilling was bartending and told Robert his wife was not in the bar. Jason and a patron, identified as Richard Schilling told Robert to leave. Robert, who was slurring his words and appeared intoxicated, backed out of the establishment. Robert caused patrons to fear for their safety. Robert then left and was later located at his residence. He was arrested and Charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Battery, Endangering Safety by Use of a Dangerous Weapon, Carry a Handgun where Alcohol sold and consumed, Disorderly Conduct with use of a Dangerous Weapon, Resisting an Officer and Stalking.

Tobacco and Alcohol Compliance checks:

On 06/27/2013, a tobacco compliance check at 13 randomly selected West Allis businesses that have a license to sell tobacco. The check was completed through the use of a 17 year old female who attempted to purchase a pack of Newport cigarettes. All of the 13 businesses requested identification from the 17 year old female and did not complete the sale.

Case #13-005625

On 06/25/2013, an alcohol compliance check was conducted at 12 randomly selected businesses that have a license to sell liquor. The check was completed through the use of an 18 year old female who attempted to purchase a six pack of Miller Lite beer. All 12 of the businesses requested identification from the 18 year old female and did not complete the sale.

NARRATIVE

COMPLIANCE CHECK OUTLINE

On 0627/13 from 1200 to 1400hrs I conducted a tobacco compliance check at 13 randomly selected businesses that have a license to sell tobacco. This check was completed through the use of an 17 year old female, Mackenzie M. Lieber, F/W 07/24/95. Lieber entered each of the randomly selected businesses and attempted to purchase a pack of Newport cigarettes without providing any identification.

I advised Lieber if the sales clerk asked her for identification, she should immediately leave the business. I provided Lieber with \$40.00 from the WAPD Crime Prevention fund for the attempted purchases.

Prior to beginning the compliance check I confirmed Lieber did not have any identification on her person, and the only item she brought with her was her cellular telephone. I took a photograph of Lieber with a department issued digital camera and secured the photograph onto a WAPD media card to document her appearance on the day of the compliance check. The media card was later secured in
