**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN
AMENDMENT TO THE CENTER SHARING AGREEMENT WITH QUAD/MED,
LLC TO IMPLEMENT THE QUADMED WELLNESS ONLINE PORTAL**

WHEREAS, the City of West Allis entered into a Center Sharing Agreement with Quad/Med, LLC, effective May 1, 2024, for the provision of employee health center services; and

WHEREAS, with the assistance of the City's employee benefits consultant, USI Insurance Services, the City conducted a comprehensive evaluation of available online wellness platforms to identify a replacement for the City's current online wellness platform; and

WHEREAS, following that evaluation, the City determined that QuadMed's Wellness Online Portal best meets the City's operational and employee wellness needs by integrating the online wellness platform with the City's existing QuadMed employee health center services, providing a more seamless experience for employees and improving administration of the City's wellness program; and

WHEREAS, implementation of the QuadMed Wellness Online Portal requires execution of the Fourth Amendment to the Center Sharing Agreement with Quad/Med, LLC.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the City Administrator, or their designee, is authorized to execute the Fourth Amendment to the Center Sharing Agreement with Quad/Med, LLC to implement the QuadMed Wellness Online Portal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Attorney is authorized to make any non-substantive changes to the approved documents to effectuate their intent and to prepare and deliver any other documents necessary to complete the approved transaction.

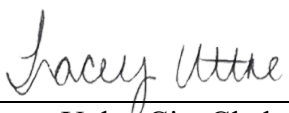

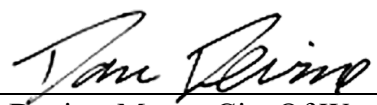
