There are new faces at the WACCC. A graphic designer was hired to enhance the look of the Community Bulletin Board, and four new board members were elected and appointed.

The WACCC is still working with the Wisconsin Association of PEG Centers to introduce legislation at the State to secure PEG funding. They have a year and a half of funding left under the current State Franchising Bill.

Six new member joined the WACCC in the first quarter. 41 programs were produced, and nine people participated in sessions for Producers, Portable Field Production and Non-Linear Editing.

It is staff's recommendation that the first quarter operating funds be allocated to the WACCC.
