Route During the 60th Street Reconstruction

As I briefly discussed at the last Board meeting, West Milwaukee rejected using 43rd Street (Miller Parkway) for the official detour during the 60th Street reconstruction. Amazingly, the vehicle counts on 43rd Street are almost equal to STH 100.

Therefore, we are looking to use 76th Street as the official detour. This would also mean temporary removal of any "no trucking" regulations. We simply don't have any better options. 84th and 92nd Streets don't work any better and STH 100 is too far away.

Since I am sure we will all receive complaints about this action, we are making you aware of it now.
