Mayor Bell and Common Council Members,

In 1978, then Director of Public Works Raymond Hahn, granted by letter an alley encroachment to Mr. Paul and Janice Easterling, 8229 W. Lapham Street for the entire width of the alley. The Easterling's currently have a fence in the undeveloped alley.

Last year, Ms. Jenna Preibisch, 1617 S. 82 Street, applied for and was granted an encroachment for her half of the alley. When we were notified of the fence problem, we also found out that we didn't have a "Grant of Privilege" for the Easterling's fence.

In August of 2002, we sent notice to the Easterling's to remove their fence and if they wished, apply for a "Grant of Privilege" for their half of the alley. After a couple of phone calls, we sent formal notice dated January 29, 2003, by certified mail, ordering the fence removal within 90 days. As of this date, the fence is still there.

Ms. Preibisch has a legal "Grant of Privilege" and would like to install their fence as soon as possible. Therefore, by way of this letter, the City Engineer and City Attorney are requesting authorization to take any and all action to cause the Easterling's fence to be removed and collect for any costs related to this action. If the City has to ultimately have to remove the fence with it's own forces, we will bill the Easterling's and if not paid, we will place the bill on their property tax.
