The library is respectfully requesting that the Purchasing Department facilitate the sole source purchase of a Cambridge Circulation Desk system from Brodart Library Supplies & Furnishings at a cost of \$14,410.00. The Cambridge system is only available through Brodart Library Supplies & Furnishings.

The Cambridge desk system is fully functional, flexible, and designed to meet the specialized, specific needs of a public library's circulation desk.
