The City Attorney's Office investigated your claim and determined that the City was not able to admit liability. Therefore, our office has concluded your claim is to be disallowed and denied. The reason(s) for the decision to disallow your claim includes, but is not limited to, the following:

The park is a space provided by The City for recreation and as such the activities there fall under the recreational immunity exemption for liability. Further, the City was unaware of the presence of any glass prior to the incident in your claim. Thus, there was no known danger present at the park.
