entering the pickup truck nearby.

I turned S/B on S 67 St and observed the pick up truck with a female party walking towards the driver's side of the vehicle. I was unable to see the rear license plate of the truck as I pulled near it in my marked West Allis Police squad car. I activated my emergency lights to stop the individuals located in the truck.

FOOT PURSUIT

The front seat passenger (khaki shorts and no shirt, bleeding from the right arm), later identified as Shawn A. Villwock, immediately exited the vehicle and began to run W/B from the truck. Villwock ran in-between the buildings and jumped over a fence where I immediately lost sight of him. Villwock ran behind 6705 W Beloit Rd and 6700 W Lincoln Ave. Due to immediately losing sight of him and Officer Schmidt holding on the west side of the building, I returned to the location of the truck Villwock ran from.

As I returned to the truck involved, several more parties were now standing at the truck and pointed out the male as he returned and began to run S/B from the area where he ran behind. I observed the male party run across W Lincoln Ave on S 67 St. I followed in my squad as he ran W/B into the alley behind W Lincoln Ave and S/B through the yard of 6710 W Monona Pl.

I yelled numerous times from my squad for him to get on the ground as my emergency lights were activated. I parked my squad as he continued to a fence at 6721 W Monona Pl. Villwock opened the fence and entered the backyard of the residence. I yelled at Villwock again to get on the ground and he did not respond. I caught up to Villwock in the backyard as he appeared to be attempting to manipulate the locking mechanism on the wood fence. I raised my conductive electronic weapon and deployed a cartridge on Villwock.

Villwock immediately fell to the ground to a seated position. Additional officers arrived on scene and Villwock was taken into custody without further incident. Villwock was brought to a standing position and walked to the alley where we met with WAFD personnel. Villwock had a small laceration to the right crook of his arm and a small amount of bleeding coming from his mouth.

MEDICAL ATTENTION

Villwock was transported to Aurora West Allis Medical Center for medical attention. Villwock received several stitches to his right arm as a result of the injuries from breaking the glass window at the business.

IN CUSTODY INTERVIEW OF OFFENDER - SHAWN VILLWOCK

On 06/24/19 at 0335hrs I spoke with Villwock in the Booking Room, Interview Room A, I read Villwock his Miranda Rights from WAPD Directive 42.016. In response to

waiver questions, Villwock stated he understood his rights and agreed to speak with me at the time.

In response to questions, Villwock stated he went to the bar with some family members of his significant other. Villwock stated he went into the bar and was only inside for approximately 10 minutes. Villwock stated he observed another male inside of the bar becoming an issue for the other people that were inside of the bar. Villwock could not remember at which point the issue with the other male became an issue for him.

Villwock stated it appeared to him that Hoecherl was being an asshole to the people that Hoecherl was with. Villwock stated the fighting going on was mainly inside of the bar. Villwock stated it was mainly between himself and Hoecherl. Villwock stated everyone else was trying to break it up.

In reference to the broken glass, Villwock admitted he smacked his hands up against the window which caused the damage. Villwock stated he returned to the truck and went inside. Villwock admitted he took off running when he saw the "lights" and ran because he did not want to get anyone else in trouble for the things that he did. Villwock stated he knew he did the bullshit to get them all in trouble.

Villwock stated it was not his intention to get involved in a physical fight tonight and only came to the bar with family members to have a drink and then go home. Villwock stated he has an alcohol issue and should not have involved himself in the issue at the bar.

INJURIES SUSTAINED BY HOECHERL

I spoke AWAMC staff who advised Hoecherl was diagnosed with a concussion but no additional broken bones or stitches required to injuries.

BOOKING

Villwock was mugged/printed using WAPD Booking #19-002233 for Criminal Damage to Property, Resisting or Obstructing an Officer, Bail Jumping - Felony and Party to - Substantial Battery - Intend Bodily Harm.

OPEN CASE

Villwock is currently out on bail for Milwaukee County Case 2019CF002363 for Theft-Movable Property >\$10,000-\$100,000 as a party to a crime. Villwock's last court date was on 6/19/19.

OBSERVATIONS OF SCENE

On 6/15/19 at 0211hrs I cleared the yards and stopped at W McGeoch Ave at W Beloit Rd. I observed, to the east, some sort of physical altercation taking place outside of Dingers, 6129 W Beloit Rd. I turned towards the business, activated my emergency lights and began to check for individuals that were injured. As I pulled forward, nearly everyone outside of the business began to enter vehicles nearby and leave the scene.

I was unable to directly see who the offender(s) involved in the incident were at the time of the incident. However, I observed some individuals quickly enter a Chevrolet SUV nearby. A nearby witness advised some of the individuals involved got into the SUV. I provided my observations of the numerous individuals entering a vehicle and began to attend to an individual on his back nearby.

PERSONAL CONTACT - MARK ZITTEL

I attempted to speak with Mark Zittel, the individual who was lying on his back. Zittel was highly intoxicated and did not possess the ability to stand on his own. Zittel stated he did not know the individuals who had attacked him. A nearby witness stated that Zittel stated "I'm right here" to the males and a large group came over to him and began to strike him.

Zittel would heavily slurring his speech but stated he only wanted to go home and sleep. Zittel stated he lived in West Milwaukee. Zittel had a small amount of blood on his nose and mouth. Zittel was unable to provide a description of the individuals who had attacked him. Zittel emitted a strong odor of intoxicants and had red, glassy eyes.

CONTACT WITH BARTENDER - DRAGAN VASILJEVIC

I briefly spoke with an employee, Dragan Vasiljevic. Dragan advised he was inside of the business at the time of the incident. Dragan stated he heard a commotion

coming from outside the business and he soon exited. Dragan did not see any part of the physical fight and confirmed there is cameras recording outside of the business.

CCTV VIDEO

I reviewed the CCTV video from the business at the time of the incident. Outside of the business, two male parties slowly walk over to where Zittel was standing. One male swings and strikes Zittel near the chest/head area. Zittel falls to the ground and both male parties strike Zittel numerous times by punching and kicking. I arrive on scene and the parties enter a vehicle which leaves the area. The vehicle stopped by Officer Schmidt did not have any occupants involved in the altercation.

CASE DISPOSITION

The two parties involved in the physical altercation with Zittel were not identified. They are two younger black males and entered an unknown vehicle. Zittel had not contacted myself regarding any further injuries or further recollection of the incident.

**OFFICER OBSERVATIONS**

On 6/15/19 at 2247hrs I was on patrol in a fully marked squad through the City of West Allis with Sgt. Gold. I observed a physical fight taking place outside of Dingers, 6139 W Beloit Rd between several males. The squad was parked and one male with a white Wisconsin sweatshirt began to run W/B on W Beloit Rd. I stayed outside of the business as two males were still wrestling outside of the business.

I began to yell police at the two males and they quickly stopped physically fighting. I attempted to speak with one male, later identified as Alan R. Kelnhofer. Kelnhofer appeared to be bleeding from the mouth and the nose. Kelnhofer was missing a shoe and did not appear to be listening to me. I advised Kelnhofer numerous times to stay on the ground. Kelnhofer responded that he was going to put his shoe back on and stood up.

Kelnhofer was advised several more times to stay on the ground and he looked away from me. Kelnhofer acknowledged my presence but soon looked away towards other individuals outside of the bar. Based upon his lack of response to me and his already aggressive behavior inside of the business, I grabbed onto Kelnhofer and pushed him to the ground. I stabilized him into his stomach where I detained him.

Kelnhofer used his weight and tried to stabilize himself against me but never physically pushed back or against me. I eventually stabilized Kelnhofer on his stomach. I ordered him to place his hands behind his back and he complied. I began to speak with Kelnhofer regarding the incident as numerous other individuals involved began to exit the business.

**STATEMENT OF OFFENDER - ALAN KELNHOFER**

I briefly spoke with Kelnhofer outside of the business. Kelnhofer stated he was inside with his buddies when he observed a physical fight inside going on. Kelnhofer did not know what started the fight. Kelnhofer first observed the male in the Wisconsin sweatshirt (Ryan Flores) strike one of his friends.

Kelnhofer observed his friend "Mike", physically fighting with Flores. Kelnhofer stated he recognized Flores from basketball but does not know him. Kelnhofer stated there was tensions in the bar when he walked in. When asked about his involvement, Kelnhofer stated "I tried to break it up, I got swung on, so I swung back". Kelnhofer stated they continued to fight with each other inside and it carried over to outside of the business. Kelnhofer stated that as a man, he

CCTV VIDEO

I reviewed the CCTV video from the business. Upon observing the video, an unknown male wearing a checkered shirt shove Ryan Flores inside of the business. Flores moves towards the front entry door to the business but does not leave. Due to poor camera angles and the mass amount of people inside of the business, it is difficult to see who eventually began to rush towards Flores as he was near the corner of the bar near the entrance.

A physical fight involving approximately 10-15 takes place between numerous males inside of the business. Flores can be clearly seen as people attempt to pull him backwards out of the fight, however, Flores is seen striking numerous times on numerous occasions. On one strike, Flores strikes a male to the head. That male in turn falls to the ground with an unknown injury. Kelnhofer is immediately seen on camera attacking Flores identified by his Bucks shirt. Kelnhofer is seen attempting to physically assault Flores.

On the exterior camera, Kelnhofer and Flores are both physically wrestling and striking each other outside of the business. Numerous other unknown and unidentified individuals also take place during the assault outside of the business.

CASE DISPOSITION

Kelnhofer and Flores were both cited for Disorderly Conduct regarding both their involvement in the physical fighting occurring at the business. Kelnhofer was cited and released from the main station and Flores was later transported to CJF on a VOP.

At the time of this investigation I was wearing my WAPD issued body camera, which was functional and activated. The body worn camera footage was categorized as municipal citation. See video recording for precise details as the following is a summary based off little or no review.

**INITIAL CALL FOR SERVICE**

On 06/22/19, at approximately 0951 hours, officers were dispatched to Tap City for a report of a patron there who was assaulted by one of the owners while at Rockstar Saloon. I responded to Tap City where I spoke with Larry C. Van Den Eng, while Officer Steffen responded to Rockstar Saloon to speak with parties involved there.

**VICTIM STATEMENT - LARRY C. VAN DEN ENG**

I spoke with Larry, who stated he was at Rockstar Saloon. Larry stated he got to the bar around 0815-0830 and was there for approximately one hour. Larry told me he was working on his drink, when he reached over the bar for the cribbage board, as he has done many times. Larry stated he was going to play a game with another person there and as soon as he had the game in his hand, he was told, "No, no, no!" Larry told me Joseph (Butterfield) was the person who told him that. Larry stated Joseph is one of the owners of the bar.

Larry stated within seconds, Joseph punched him in the face and was yelling at him to get out of the bar.

Larry stated he left the bar and Joseph followed him outside and said something and punched him in the face one more time. I observed Larry had a bruise under his left eye, by his cheek bone and a laceration above his right eye. Larry denied medical attention.

**LACK OF CONSENT**

Larry did not give Joseph permission to hit him, causing injury.

**WITNESS STATEMENT - MELISSA M. JANS**

I spoke with Jans, who was outside of Tap City, in her vehicle. I asked her what happened at Rockstar and she told me she was not inside the bar and does not know what happened inside. She did tell me that when Larry came outside, he told her that Joseph had punched him in the face.

Jans then told me Joseph had followed Larry outside and Larry asked someone to get his cigarettes for him, which they did. Jans then witnessed Joseph hit Larry on the face. Jans stated, with the punch, Joseph broke Larry's glasses.

**ARREST**

After conversing with Officer Steffen about the incident, it was determined that more follow up was needed. Officer Steffen and I responded back to Rockstar and spoke with Joseph again. Joseph did not wish to answer many of the follow up questions asked of him. He also stated the video cameras which appeared to be working did not work.

Based on Joseph following Larry out of the bar and striking him again, he was arrested for battery. Officer Steffen conveyed him to the station for processing. Larry was issued a municipal citation for battery.

**CASE DISPOSITION**

There is no additional follow up required for this incident. A tavern report has been completed.
