Resolution approving an amendment to the Community Development Block Grant Action Plan, B-08-MC-55-0011 creating the Pedestrian Improvement Project between S. 70 St. and S. 76 St along W. Greenfield Ave.

WHEREAS, the Pedestrian Improvement Project and the aforesaid project costs are eligible for Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) funds; and,

WHEREAS, the project activity is for the removal of crosswalks in the Downtown West Allis Business Improvement District; and,

WHEREAS, the neighborhood would be best served by improving the condition of crosswalks and enhancing the vitality of the downtown; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Development has recommended approval of this project.

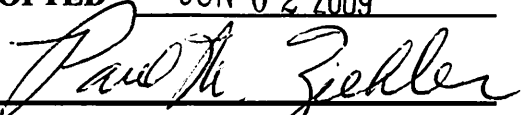
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funding for the Pedestrian Improvement Project be made available through a reduction to the following program:
