West Allis Community Communications Corporation (WACCC)

Date: 12/10/09

The WACCC is working with the Wisconsin Association of PEG Channels to secure PEG funding by revising the State Franchising Bill. Legislation is being formulated by Rep. Hebl from Sun Prairie, but has not been introduce as of this communication.

During the third quarter the WACCC covered Fourth of July activities, National Night Out and the Open House at the new Heritage Senior Living Residence. Five people attended workshops on editing, studio training, field production and producing programs. Eleven people renewed their membership and five new members joined the WACCC brining the total number of members to 40. 55 programs were produced in the third quarter.

The WACCC had a window display at the Library for the month of September. Their Policy Committee has been reviewing the type of programs on Channel 14, and is formulating a policy limiting types of programming to a certain percentage, so the Channel maintains its diversity.

The WACCC is continuing to fulfill the requirements stated in their 2009 goals and objectives. I recommend providing $3^{\rm rd}$ quarter funding for the WACCC.
