Water main was being repaired on 8/12/25. City Workers shut off water, did give notification about shut off. Around the time stated above when their work was complete, they repressurized the line causing over pressurization of home plumbing causing a fitting to break vertically on the second floor of residence. This caused water to go through the walls from the second floor to the basement. My son went outside and asked neighbors if they experienced anything similar, and they said a city worker told them to open their bath tub faucet and basement faucet to prevent overpressurization of their plumbing. My son asked the crew if they went door to door and or just asked if they notified just certain people. At this time what im assuming was the crew lead became "very defensive stating he watched with his own eyes, someone on the crew going door to door." This is not true because we have 2 dogs in my home that would have barked, additionally we have had people coming in and out of the house all day due to the flooding that occurred in the basement from the weather on 8/10/25. My basement already cost thousands of dollars to repair and replace all of my appliances, and now with the water from the second floor, im scared that mold will grow in the walls. There is already paint bubbling up on the ceiling of the kitchen. Additionally we had water coming out of the door jams and the venting for the downstairs bathroom. The water made its way all the way back into the basement.
