Upon deliberation and consideration of the complaint presented at the License and Health Committee meeting held on May 21, 2014, the Committee finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That ARH Enterprises, LLC, by agent Hugo Jose Juarez, was served a copy of the summons and complaint;
- 2. That ARH Enterprises, LLC, by Attorney Dan Meylink, stipulated that sufficient grounds were stated in the complaint for the imposition of sanctions and, thus, the allegations in the complaint are considered to be true;
- 3. That ARH Enterprises, LLC agrees to follow the attached stipulation at Las Palmas, 1901 South 60th Street, in lieu of any punitive action by the License and Health Committee and/or the Common Council.
- 4. That the stipulation provided that both the City of West Allis and ARH Enterprises, LLC are bound to the terms of the stipulation, and failure of either party to comply with said terms will result in continuation of the hearing procedures set forth in Wis. Stat. 125.12(2)(b);

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

1. That the conduct of ARH Enterprises, LLC, d/b/a Las Palmas, described in the complaint substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensed activity contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(c);

RECOMMENDATION:

Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that it adopt the stipulation entered into by Assistant City Attorney Jenna Merten, on behalf of the City of West Allis, and Dan Meylink and Hugo Jose Juarez, on behalf of ARH Enterprises, LLC, in regard to Las Palmas.
