

**CITY OF WEST ALLIS
RESOLUTION R-2026-1301**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT
VIRTUAL SERVER AND BACKUP SYSTEM FROM CDW-G FOR \$100,020**

WHEREAS, the City of West Allis relies on a centralized virtual server system to operate essential software, store electronic records, and support daily operations across all City departments; and

WHEREAS, the City's current virtual server system, powered by Scale Computing, was installed in 2021 at City Hall and has now reached the end of its manufacturer-supported life cycle, meaning it will no longer receive security updates, technical support, or hardware replacement coverage; and

WHEREAS, continuing to operate unsupported equipment poses risks to data security, system reliability, and continuity of City services; and

WHEREAS, the proposed replacement system combines servers, data storage, and backup protection into a single integrated platform that will be installed in the City's new data center at the Department of Public Works facility and will support all City departments; and

WHEREAS, applications and files currently stored on the existing system will be securely migrated to the new system throughout 2026 to ensure uninterrupted City operations; and

WHEREAS, this project was reviewed and approved as part of the 2026 Capital Improvement Program (CIP); and

WHEREAS, a quote dated February 17, 2026, in the amount of \$100,020 has been received from CDW-G, representing competitive and appropriate pricing for the required hardware, software licensing, and backup solution;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that:

1. The proposal from CDW-G dated February 17, 2026, for the purchase of a virtual server and backup solution for \$100,020 is approved.
2. The cost of the physical Scale System (hardware) of \$80,000 will be charged to the CIP account number 352-1101-517.70-09.
3. The first-year annual maintenance of \$20,020 will be charged to the IT General account number 100-1101-517.32-01.
4. The Information Technology Department is authorized to execute all necessary documents and agreements to complete this purchase and implement the system.




