Re: 4th Quarter Funding for Educational Access

Date: 1/29/03

All 16 educational facilities now have video clubs. There are more than 100 students involved in the video clubs. There are also 50 students enrolled in the video production classes at West Milwaukee Middle School and Central High School.

The re-opening of the Parkway Elementary School has provided an area for the video clubs and the School District's Information Office, which oversees programming on the Educational Access Channel and produces District wide programs. The area in the school is being converted into a studio for school "news" broadcasts. Equipment and production materials used by the video clubs are also stored at the Parkway School.

After reviewing the School District activities relating to the educational access channel, I recommend that the fourth quarter funding for educational access television operations be granted.
