July 31, 2014	Fire	The fire department Gator/Ambulance was being operated at the State Fair when the vehicles canopy struck a booth. Minimal Damage.	Suspension of driving privileges for a period of at least 60 days. The members must go through supervised drivers training for a minimum of 6 hours. The member must complete the driver's training course successfully prior to the reinstatement of driving privileges.	The employee has 3 years on the department and has had 2 prior accidents (both fairly minor with little damage) The employee had received a verbal and written reprimand for the prior incidents.
July 31, 2014	Fire	After having responded to a residence and assessing a patient the driver of Med 113 moved the unit from the street into an alleyway due to better access for the patient and cot. While exiting the alley, which was a T alley, the driver turned left. It was very tight with a telephone pole at the edge of the alley at the T. The driver was focusing on not hitting the telephone pole when the top rear of the ambulance box struck a garage overhang. There were only scratches to the ambulance but an estimate to fix the garage was \$650.00.	No Discipline.	Driver has 5 years on the job with no prior incidents.

August 27, 2014	Fire	Med 1 was parked while on an emergency call when it was struck by a truck making a turn onto the street. The members were in the residence attending to a patient when the vehicle was hit. They were informed of the accident by a bystander that entered the residence.	No Discipline. Driver not at fault.	The driver has 3 years on the job. No prior incidents.
August 28, 2014	Fire	The driver of the 2012 Ford Escape was backing out of a parking stall at city hall when the vehicle was struck in the right rear quarter-panel by another vehicle that was backing out.	No Discipline. Driver not at fault.	The driver has 15 years on the job with 2 prior accidents. One accident resulted in a verbal reprimand the other was not his fault.
