Dear Council Members:

The enclosed claim has been referred to this office in accordance with Section 3.05 (6)(a) of the Revised Municipal Code. This office has examined the facts of the claim and the applicable law. Our Opinion regarding liability is as follows:

It is the recommendation of this office that the following claim be denied:

James Hannon - Amount: \$ 1,021.79

This is a claim for vehicle damage to the claimant's van on February 19th, 2008, when the vehicle allegedly bottomed out while existing an alley at or near 971 South 60th Street, West Allis, WI. The claimant alleges in his claim that the damage to his van was caused by a build up of ice and snow at the entrance-way approach to the alley, which he struck with the van while attempting to pull out of the alley onto the street. The claimant obtained an estimate for repair from an auto repair facility and filed a claim against the City on February 22nd, 2008.

Our investigation into this claim did show that the approach to the alley referenced in the claimant's claim did have a build up of snow and ice with various spots of melting down to the cement causing a few ruts in the roadway. However, the condition of the alley was no different than any other alley within the City at this time of the year taking into consideration the excessive amount of snowfall that has occurred to date this winter. The alley and entrance way were satisfactorily plowed so that vehicles could enter and exit; however, caution was needed by any individual driver in maneuvering in and out of the alley. In other words, the City did not take any specific action or fail to take action resulting in damage to the claimant's vehicle. Furthermore, even if this rose to the level of a danger or defect in the roadway, the fact that the City did not have knowledge of it prior to the claimant's incident, along with the timeframe specified in the law for the City to remove snow and ice on roadways aid in making the City immune from liability in this situation. This is a matter whereby an operator of a vehicle must proceed with extreme caution and if not, is a proper claim to be handled by the insurance carrier for the vehicle.

Based upon the above, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office to deny this claim pursuant to the provisions of Wisconsin Municipal Claims Statute 893.80.
