This letter is to recommend the sole source purchase of additional licenses of Phoenix's Wireless Digital Assistance (WDA) software to be used in each of the Fire Department's rigs. This is the same software used in the Police Squads and is interfaced into the 911 and dispatch programs. The WDA's will allow the fire personnel to see call address, call details, property information, floor plans, dispatcher comments, fire hydrant locations, warnings, maps, etc. with the rig in real time. The software is part of the Police Department Phoenix system and is only available from ProPhoenix.
