The following is a summary of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service during the month of March.

Incident reports:

Case #14-10938, 12/08/2014, 0346 hrs: 9033 W. National Av – J. Beans Pub

On 12/08/2014, Officers responded to the alley behind 5719 W. Rogers St for a report of a man passed out on the ground. Investigation revealed a party had fallen and hit his head and vomited on himself. WAFD was called and responded to the scene. The party passed away. On 01/30/2015, information was received the death may be from over-serving of alcohol at a tavern in West Allis, J. Beans Pub, 9033 W. National Av. An autopsy was conducted and the cause of death was listed as "Anoxic Encephalopathy" due to "Blunt Force Injuries of the Head" and the manner of death was listed as "Accident". An investigation ensued. When Detectives asked the bar owner who was serving that night, they stated a girl called "J Little". They would not provide her name, address or telephone number. Detectives were also advised this bartender no longer works at the tavern. The bar owner claimed to have no employment documentation concerning this bartender, nor payroll slips. The owner stated she believed she was a licensed bartender, but she did not have any documentation of the bartending license from the City of West Allis. Detectives were able to determine the identity of the bartender and Monica Schultz, City Hall, advised this party did not have a bartender license issued to her. The other owner then stated it was another party who was bartending and she was a licensed bartender.

Case #15-11552, 03/19/2015, 1520 hrs: 6007 W. Burnham St – Las Palmas

On 03/19/2015, Officers were flagged down at Las Palmas for a report of a Theft. A party was drinking, left a \$100 bill on the bar in front of him, and then he fell asleep for a few moments. When he awoke, the money was gone and the person he had been drinking with was also gone.

Case #15-11917, 03/21/2015, 2200 hrs: 900 S. 74 St – Walk Her Inn

On 03/21/2015, Officer responded to Walk Her In for a weapons call involving a male with a knife and numerous males fighting. After a brief search of the area one male party was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct – While Armed and Obstructing an Officer. Another female party was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct. Investigation revealed the male party was highly intoxicated and was arguing with people inside the bar when he revealed he just got out of jail, pulled out a knife and told patrons he could take all of them. A patron called the police for help.

Case #15-11931 03/22/2015, 0051 hrs: 837 S. 108 St - Kip's Inn

On 03/22/2015, Officers responded to Kip's Inn for a report of a fight in the street, outside the establishment. Three parties were all fighting due to an incident that began inside the bar. All three parties were arrested and cited for Disorderly Conduct and released. The bartender called police for assistance.

Case #15-12267, 03/23/2015, 2244 hrs: 7411 W. Becher St - Barneks

On 03/23/2015, Officers responded to Barneks for a report of a disorderly male. Contact was made with staff and patrons who advised a party was throwing items around inside the bar and making a scene. The party punched the front door multiple times, causing damage after being thrown out of the bar. Officers took custody of the party in his home and arrested him for Disorderly Conduct and Criminal Damage to Property.

Tobacco and Alcohol Compliance checks:

Case #15-12010, 03/22/2015, at 1700 hrs:

On 03/22/2015, Officers conducted a tobacco compliance check at 13 randomly selected West Allis businesses that have a license to sell tobacco. The check was completed through the use of a 17 year old male who attempted to purchase a pack of cigarettes. Out of the 13 businesses, 10 asked for identification and would not complete the sale without it. Three of the businesses completed the sale and allowed the purchase of a pack of cigarettes without identification. The employees were cited for Selling Tobacco Products to Minors. Owners from all three businesses were also issued citations through the mail.

Express Pantry – 8530 W. Greenfield Av Kwik Pantry – 5631 W. National Av In and Out Grocery – 5932 W. Burnham St.

INITIAL RESPONSE

On 12/08/14 at approx. 0346hrs. Officers responded to 5719 W. Rogers St for the call of a man passed out on the ground by a maroon car behind 5719 W. Rogers St.

CONTACT WITH ANDREA G. SIMET

I made contact with the resident at 5719 W. Rogers St., Andrea G. Simet, F/W 05/19/86. I informed her that Glenn M. Meyer, M/W 04/01/55, had fallen and hit his head on the pavement in the alley behind their residence and he would be transported to AWAMH.

CONTACT WITH ALLEN M. MEYER

I also made contact with Allen M. Meyer, M/W 02/16/90. I advised Allen of what happened to Glenn.

NARRATIVE

PO Kaye Reports:

On 12/08/14 at approximately 0346hrs, officers responded to the 2000Blk east/west alley between S 57 St/S 58 St, for a report of an M/W passed out on the ground next to a vehicle.

Upon arrival I observed an older M/W in a black leather jacket lying on the ground behind a blue 1994 Chevrolet Caprice 4Dr (WI - 796WTE). I later identified the individual by the WI DL located in his wallet as Glenn Michael Meyer (M/W 04/01/55). The blue Chevrolet listed to Glenn as well. Glenn was lying on his right side on the cement apron leading from the garage (5719 W Rogers St) to the alleyway. Glenn's head was pointed east and feet to the west. Glenn was facing the garage (North).

I noticed the driver's door of Glenn's vehicle was wide open and the dome light was on. The vehicle was not running as I observed a set of keys on the ground near Glenn, as well as a pack of cigarettes, and a lighter. I immediately attempted to make contact with Glenn.

I identified myself and told Glenn to wake up. Glenn did not respond. Glenn was breathing heavily in a snoring like fashion. Glenn was not conscious but was breathing. I yelled for Glenn to wake up but Glenn did not respond. I noticed Glenn had vomited as there was vomit on Glenn's face, hands, arms, shirt, and on the ground. I detected the strong odor of intoxicants emitting from Glenn's vomit.

I decided to have the WAPD Dispatch send a WAFD MED Unit to the scene because Glenn was incapacitated, had vomited, and was not responded to me. I continued to attempt to wake Glenn up. I rolled Glenn onto his back and attempted a Sternum Rub multiple times in attempts to get a response from

Glenn. Glenn did not respond. Because Glenn would not respond to any stimuli I was attempting to use, I rolled Glenn back onto his right side as I did not want Glenn to choke on his vomit. I continued to try to get Glenn to wake up by yelling to him but did not get a response.

While waiting for the WAFD MED Unit to arrive, I noticed a small laceration to the back of Glenn's head and a small amount of blood on the pavement under Glenn's head. Shortly thereafter the WAFD MED Unit arrived on scene and tended to Glenn.

I located Glenn's wallet in his back right pants pocket. There was cash and his WI DL inside of his wallet. Glenn's property was collected and sent with him on the WAFD MED Unit, which conveyed Glenn to Froedtert Hospital.

CALLER STATEMENT - RIANA M. STROMSKI

On 12/09/14, I spoke with Riana M. Stromski (F/W 10/16/89) over the phone in regards to this incident. Riana explained she resides at 2028 S 58 St, and was on her way to work at approximately 0345hrs on 12/08/14. Riana stated her vehicle was parked on the parking slab off the alleyway behind her residence. Riana said she drove her vehicle north through the alley and turned west towards S 58 St to exit the alley.

Riana told me she noticed an older M/W with gray hair and dark colored jacket lying on the ground in the east/west alleyway behind a vehicle which still had the driver's door open and the dome light on (The individual Riana observed and the individual I located are the same person, Glenn). Riana stated she did not know Glenn. Riana believed Glenn was lying on his stomach, face down, at the time she noticed him. Riana did not observe anyone else around the area.

Riana indicated she noticed there were cigarettes on the ground near Glenn as well as some other items. Riana stated she did not get out and attempt to make contact with Glenn but rather contacted to Police right away.

NARRATIVE

Detective Hurley reports:

CASE ASSIGNMENT:

On 01/30/15, I was assigned this case by Captain Waddell for further investigation. On 12/08/14 at approximately 0346 hours, officers were dispatched to the alley located behind 5719 W. Rogers St. It was reported that a male party was passed out on the ground by a vehicle.

Officers located a male party, identified as Glenn M. Meyer, M/W, 04/01/55, who had fallen, struck his head, and vomited on himself. Officer Kaye observed that Glenn was lying on the ground behind a blue colored 1994 Chevrolet 4 DR, with WI AUT plate 796-WTE. The vehicle listed to Glenn Meyer, and Glenn was laying on his right side on the cement apron leading from the garage, located at 5719 W. Rogers St., to the alley way. Officer Kay observed the driver's side door of Glenn's vehicle was open, the dome light was on, and

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the vehicle was not running. He located a set of keys on the ground near Glenn, as well as a pack of cigarettes and a lighter.

Officer Kaye attempted contact several times with Glenn, but he did not respond to stimuli. He observed vomit on Glenn's face, hands, arms, shirt, and on the ground. There was also a strong odor of an intoxicating beverage emanating from Glenn's vomit. Officer Kaye observed a small laceration to the back of Glenn's head, and he requested a WAFD MED unit respond to the scene to tend to Glenn.

WAFD personnel responded to the scene, and they transported Glenn Meyer to the Froedtert Hospital, 9200 W. Wisconsin Ave., for medical attention.

Unfortunately; Glenn Meyer passed away due to his injuries, and he was pronounced dead on 12/08/14 at 1845 hours by Dr. Munyaradzi Chimukangara at Froedtert Hospital. He was found to have a BAC of 0.19 and subdural hemorrhage.

Forensic Investigator Anne-Marie Eschle, of the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office, was notified by Froedtert Hospital of Glenn Meyer's death. Investigator Eschle was advised by Dr. Raymond Roewe that Glenn was intubated in the trauma bay and sent of a CT scan. He was found to have subdural hemorrhage and Glenn herniated. The bleed was non-survivable, and family elected to withdraw care.

On 12/08/14 at approximately 2113 hours, Investigator Eschle made contact with Glenn Meyer's son, identified as Allen Meyer. Allen stated he last had contact with Glenn on 12/07/14 at approximately 2300 hours after they left a Christmas party. Glenn was going to meet with a friend at a bar, and Allen indicated Glenn met with his friend and he (Glenn) fell after returning home from the tavern. Glenn was found by a neighbor this morning lying on the ground next to his vehicle. Allen did not believe Glenn was assaulted, because Glenn's keys and wallet were located on his person.

STATEMENT OF CONTACT: RIANA STROMSKI:

On 12/09/14, Officer Kaye made telephone contact with Riana Stromski, of 2028 S. 58th St. Riana advised Officer Kaye that she was on her way to work on 12/08/14 at approximately 0345 hours. Her vehicle was parked on the parking slab off the alley way behind her residence. Riana drove her vehicle northbound through the alley, and she turned westbound toward S. 58th St. to exit the alley.

She observed an older white male party with light colored gray hair and a dark colored jacket lying on the ground in the east/west alley behind a vehicle, which still had the driver's side door open and the dome light on. This male party was later identified as Glenn Meyer. She believed Glenn has lying on

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his stomach face down, at the time she noticed him. She did not observe anyone else in the immediate area.

Riana did not attempt to make contact with Glenn, but she immediately contacted police.

FINAL CAUSE OF DEATH:

On 01/30/15, Captain Waddell was provided with a copy of Glenn Meyer's autopsy report. The immediate cause of death was listed as ANOXIC ENCEPHALOPATHY due to Blunt Force Injuries of the Head.

The final manner of death was listed as ACCIDENT.

The death certificate was signed by Brian Linert, M.D., on 12/09/14.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION / DEPT OF REVENUE COMPLAINT:

On 01/29/15, Monica Schultz, City Clerk for the City of West Allis, was contacted by an agent from the Department of Revenue-Alcohol Enforcement Division.

A relative of Glenn Meyer, identified as "Shealynn," complained to the Department of Revenue that Glenn Meyer was over served at J. Beans Pub, located at 9033 W. National Ave.

On 01/30/15, Monica Schultz contacted Captain Waddell, and she requested that WAPD follow up on this complaint for possible referral to the License and Health Committee.

ATTEMPTED TELEPHONE CONTACT WITH ALLEN MEYER:

On 02/03/15 at approximately 1955 hours, I attempted telephone contact with Allen Meyer at telephone number (414) 870-0451.

There was no answer, and I received an automated message stating the caller's voicemail box has not been set up. I was unable to leave a message.

FOLLOW UP INVESTIGATION: 5719 W ROGERS ST:

On 02/03/15 at approximately 2100 hours, Detective Mees and I responded to the residence located at 5719 W. Rogers St. for follow up investigation.

Upon arrival, I knocked on the front door of the residence several times, but there was no answer. I left my business card advising Allen Meyer to contact

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me at the station regarding this incident.

On 02/10/15 at approximately 2210 hours, I responded to the residence located at 5719 W. Rogers St. for follow up investigation.

Upon arrival, I made contact with a male party, verbally identified as Allen M. Meyer, M/W, 02/16/90, inside the residence.

STATEMENT OF CONTACT: ALLEN MEYER:

I advised Allen that I was conducting follow up investigation regarding a complaint that West Allis City Hall received from the WI Department of Revenue-Alcohol Enforcement Division. Allen stated he was contacted by his mother approximately three weeks ago, and Allen's mother advised him that his half sister "Shealynn" claimed Glenn Meyer was over served at J. Beans Pub, 9033 W. National Ave.

Shealynn further stated the State of Wisconsin ruled Glenn Meyer's death "suspicious," and the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's office did not perform an autopsy on Glenn Meyer. She further claimed the State of Wisconsin was going to "shut down" J. Beans Pub, and Shealynn mentioned there might be a possible lawsuit or settlement. Allen noted he was contacted by the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's office, there was an autopsy performed, and Glenn's death was ruled accidental.

Allen advised me Shealynn is known to make stories up, and he described Shealynn as a "chronic liar." Allen provided me with Shealynn's telephone number of (319) 899-0476. He believed Shealynn's last name was "Ingles," and Shealynn resides in an unknown city in the State of Iowa. (Note: I later searched Accurint records and I located the following information for Shealynn: Shealynn D. Ingalls, F/W, 08/16/81, of 2872 J Ave, Apt. A, Williamsburg, IA 52361).

Allen said he was at a Christmas party with his father, Glenn Meyer, during the evening hours of 12/07/15. Allen noted Glenn consumed a few beers at the Christmas party, but he did not believe Glenn was intoxicated. Glenn dropped Allen off at their residence at approximately 2300 hours, and Glenn was supposed to meet his friend "Bob Burkard" at J. Beans Pub. He mentioned that Glenn was lucid, and he was talking with several people at the Christmas party prior to driving over to J. Beans Pub. Allen stated his father missed Bob Burkard by a few minutes, and Bob Burkard ending up leaving J. Beans Pub before Glenn arrived there. He provided me with Bob's telephone number of (414) 475-0423.

Allen did not know who Glenn could have met at the tavern during the early morning hours of 12/08/14. He was told Glenn played pool with an unknown male party, but Allen stated he would try to find out the male party's name and

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telephone number for me. Allen's other sister "Stephanie" was able to check video surveillance at J. Beans Pub after the accident, and Allen believed Glenn left the tavern on 12/08/14 at approximately 0200 hours.

Allen noted Glenn parked his vehicle "very straight" the morning of 12/08/14. Allen did not believe Glenn was intoxicated, because his vehicle would have been parked very crooked and not straight. He added the driveway of their residence was "very slick" and covered in ice. Allen added the incline of the driveway approach is steep and it was covered in ice. He believes Glenn slipped on the ice, he fell down, and struck his head on the ground.

Allen was woken up by officers at 0430 hours, and he was advised that Glenn was unconscious and being transported to Froedtert Hospital for medical attention by WAFD personnel.

I provided Allen with my business card, and Allen stated he would contact me at the station with the name of the male party Glenn played billiards with at J. Beans Pub on the morning of 12/08/14.

FOLLOW UP INVESTIGATION: 9033 W NATIONAL AVE:

On 02/11/15 at approximately 2230 hours, Detective Phillippi and I responded to J. Beans Pub, located at 9033 W. National Ave., for follow up investigation.

Upon arrival; detectives made contact with the bar owner, verbally identified as Jason J. Powelski, M/W, 05/06/76, inside the business.

STATEMENT OF CONTACT: JASON POWELSKI:

I advised Jason of the complaint received by West Allis City Hall, and Jason stated he was aware that Glenn Meyer fell down and later passed away. Jason stated he checked the video surveillance footage on 12/09/14, at the request of his friend "Stephanie," who is a relative of Glenn Meyer. He added that he (Jason) met Glenn in the past as well, but did not really know Glenn Meyer that well.

Jason advised me that Glenn came into the tavern on 12/07/14 at approximately 2200 hours. He was by himself, and Jason did not know if Glenn met up with anyone at the bar. Jason stated there were approximately six to eight other patrons inside the tavern at that time. He did not remember which bartender served Glenn that evening.

Jason observed Glenn playing billiards with an unknown male party inside the tavern, and Glenn was also consuming beer at the bar. He estimated Glenn consumed between six to eight bottles of beer, believed to be either Budweiser or Miller Lite. Jason noted that Glenn only drank beer, and he did not

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consume any shots. Glenn's behavior inside the tavern appeared to be normal, and Jason noted that Glenn did not appear to be overly intoxicated. He was not "falling over drunk," Glenn was not acting strange in any way, and he did not get involved in any altercations with other tavern patrons.

Jason stated Glenn left the tavern at approximately 0200 hours on 12/08/14, and Glenn was by himself when he left. Jason has four video surveillance cameras inside the tavern, and he does not have any video cameras on the outside of the tavern.

The video surveillance footage is only saved for two weeks. The video footage from 12/08/14 has already been deleted, and Jason did not save a copy. He was unable to provide me with further information at this time.

FOLLOW UP INVESTIGATION: 9033 W NATIONAL AVE:

On 02/12/15 at approximately 2200 hours, Detective Mees and I responded to J. Beans Pub, 9033 W. National Ave., for follow up investigation.

Upon arrival; detectives made contact with the other bar owner, identified as Jill M. Lisowski, F/W, 09/01/64, inside the business.

STATEMENT OF CONTACT: JILL LISOWSKI:

Jill advised me that she was not working on 12/07/14, but she was aware that I spoke with Jason Powelski yesterday. I asked Jill if she knew the name of the bartender that served Glenn Meyer during the late hours of 12/07/14 to the early morning hours of 12/08/14.

Jill stated the bartender working that evening was "Jenny," who everyone at the tavern called "J Little." She did not know Jenny's last name, and Jill could not provide me with Jenny's address or telephone number. Jill believed Jenny used to live on S. 85th St. in West Allis, but she may have moved to the Village of Wales.

Jill said Jenny worked at J. Beans for approximately six months. She no longer works for the tavern, and was let go between 12/20/14 and 12/28/14. Jill did not know the exact date, but added Jenny's personal problems started affecting her performance at work so Jill had to terminate Jenny's employment. She remarked that Jenny had a warrant for her arrest, and she was taken into custody while working at the tavern.

Jill mentioned she would have to look for Jenny's contact information, but she will contact me at the station once Jenny's information is located. I provided Jill with my business card and contact information.

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SEARCH OF PHOENIX RECORDS:

On 02/12/15, I conducted a search of WAPD Phoenix records for any warrant arrests at J. Beans Pub, 9033 W. National Ave. On 03/09/14, Officer Kmichik arrested a female party identified as Jennifer L. Rodriguez, F/W, 05/05/74 on a WAPD warrant. Jennifer Rodriguez posted bail, and she was released from the station.

Jennifer's last known address is 8515 W. Hayes Ave., West Allis, WI 53227, Cell phone: (414) 477-1991.

TELEPHONE CONTACT WITH SHEALYNN INGALLS:

On 02/13/15 at approximately 1600 hours, a female party verbally identified as "Shealynn Ingalls," contacted me at the station. She provided me with her cellular telephone number of (319) 899-0476, and address of 801 Pacific St., Ladora, IA 52251.

Shealynn wanted to advise me of questionable behavior regarding her sister "Stephanie Wendt," and her association with the owners of J. Beans Pub. Stephanie currently dates a male party named "Brad," who is the best friend of Jason Powelski, one of the owners of J. Beans Pub. Shealynn noted that on 12/09/14, Stephanie contacted parties at J. Beans Pub, and she advised them that Glenn Meyer had passed away.

Stephanie requested that Jason look at the video surveillance footage, to see how many drinks Glenn consumed inside the tavern during the late evening hours of 12/07/14 and the early morning hours of 12/08/14. Jason told Stephanie that Glenn consumed four beers inside the tavern, based on his observations of the video surveillance footage. Stephanie then allegedly told Jason to cover their tracks, regarding any information they know about Glenn Meyer being inside the bar that evening. Jason then deleted the video surveillance footage. Shealynn stated that Stephanie wanted to protect the tavern, and she did not want J. Beans to get in trouble.

Shealynn admitted that her father, Glenn Meyer, was a "career alcoholic." She did not believe that Glenn was only drinking beer inside the tavern that evening. Shealynn advised me that Glenn would only drink beer at home, but Glenn would consume mixed drinks when he would go out to taverns. She identified his drink of choice as "Rum and Diet Coke," and Glenn was well known in several taverns throughout the City of West Allis and the immediate area. He drank "Rum and Diet Cokes" to mask that he (Glenn) was drinking heavily.

I advised Shealynn that bar owner Jason Powelski claimed to not have known who was tending bar that evening, and bar owner Jill Lisowski could only provide me with the first name of the bartender who served Glenn Meyer during the late

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evening hours of 12/07/14 and the early morning hours of 12/08/14. Shealynn noted that both Jason and Jill were well aware of the bartender that served Glenn that evening, and they were both lying to police. She added that Glenn "had a thing" for the female bartender that served him that evening, and Shealynn heard from other parties that this bartender will be "devastated" when she finds out Glenn passed away. Shealynn did not know the name of this female bartender.

Shealynn expressed concerns that Glenn was over served inside the tavern that evening, and this bartender should have offered to call Glenn a taxi cab instead of allowing Glenn to drive home intoxicated.

Shealynn will contact me at the station if she finds out any additional information regarding this female bartender.

ATTEMPTED CONTACT AT 8515 W HAYES AVE:

On 02/13/15 at approximately 2030 hours, Officer Kwasinski and I attempted contact with Jennifer Rodriguez at the residence located at 8515 W. Hayes Ave. I knocked on the front door of the residence several times, but there was no answer. I did not observe any lights on inside the residence.

I left my business card, with note written on the back, advising Jennifer to contact me at the station.

ATTEMPTED TELEPHONE CONTACT WITH JENNIFER RODRIGUEZ:

On 02/13/15 at approximately 2100 hours, I attempted telephone contact with Jennifer Rodriguez at telephone number (414) 477-1991.

There was no answer, and I received an automated message stating the caller's voicemail box has not been set up yet. I was unable to leave a message.

TELEPHONE CONTACT WITH ALLEN MEYER:

On 02/13/15 at approximately 2315 hours, I made telephone contact with Allen Meyer at telephone number (414) 870-0451. Allen confirmed Shealynn's address in the State of Iowa, and the bartender "Jenny" no longer works at J. Beans Pub.

Allen stated he will try to speak to his sister Stephanie, and find out additional information regarding the bartender "Jenny." He will contact me at the station with any new information.

ATTEMPTED TELEPHONE CONTACT WITH JENNIFER RODRIGUEZ:

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On 02/17/15 at approximately 1755 hours, I attempted telephone contact with Jennifer Rodriguez at telephone number (414) 477-1991.

There was no answer, and I received an automated message stating the caller's voicemail box has not been set up yet. I was unable to leave a message.

SEARCH OF ACCURINT RECORDS:

On 02/17/15, I conducted a search of Accurint records for Jennifer L. Rodriquez, F/W, 05/05/74.

I located two recent address entries for Jennifer: 8515 W. Hayes Ave. and 7127 W. St. Paul Ave., Milwaukee, WI 53213. The name "Nicholas Poniewaz" and telephone number (414) 771-6233 were associated with 7127 W. St. Paul Ave.

FOLLOW UP INVESTIGATION: 7127 W ST PAUL AVE:

On 02/17/15 at approximately 1930 hours, Detective Phillippi and I responded to the residence located at 7127 W. St. Paul Ave., in the City of Milwaukee, for follow up investigation.

Upon arrival, I made contact with a male party, verbally identified as "Nick," at the front door of the residence.

STATEMENT OF CONTACT: NICK:

Nick refused to provide me with his last name or his telephone number. He remarked that he (Nick) has "his own issues with police." I asked Nick if Jennifer Rodriguez lived at the residence, and he replied, "No."

Nick stated he is a friend of Jennifer's, but he refused to provide me with Jennifer's telephone number or her current address. He added that Jennifer worked as a "cleaner" at J. Beans Pub, but Nick was not sure if Jennifer was a bartender at the tavern. I provided Nick with my business card, and I advised Nick that I needed to speak with Jennifer regarding an important matter. Nick said he would pass my information along to Jennifer.

He refused to provide me with further information regarding Jennifer's location.

(Note: Through WAPD Phoenix contacts, Nick was later identified as Nicholas P. Poniewaz, M/W, 11/18/80)

ATTEMPTED TELEPHONE CONTACT WITH SHEALYNN INGALLS:

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On 02/17/15 at approximately 2045 hours, I attempted telephone contact with Shealynn Ingalls at telephone number (319) 899-0476.

There was no answer, and I left a voicemail message advising Shealynn to contact me at the station.

CONTACT WITH WEST ALLIS CITY HALL:

On 02/19/15, I received an email from Monica Schultz, City Clerk for the City of West Allis. Monica provided me with a list of parties that listed the address of 9033 W. National Ave. on their operator license applications. There were two female parties, with the first name of Jennifer, that have operator licenses listing the address 9033 W. National Ave.:

NEGATIVE CONTACT WITH JENNIFER_RODRIGUEZ:

As of 1900 hours on 02/19/15, Jennifer Rodriguez has not contacted me at the station regarding this incident.

FOLLOW UP INVESTIGATION: 9033 W NATIONAL AVE:

On 02/20/15 at approximately 1745 hours, Detective Mees and I responded to J. Beans Pub, 9033 W. National Ave., for follow up investigation.

Upon arrival, I made contact with tavern owner Jill Lisowski inside the business.

SECONDARY STATEMENT OF CONTACT: JILL LISOWSKI:

I asked Jill if she was able to locate a telephone number or any identifying information for the bartender "Jenny," who Jill identified as the bartender that was working the evening of 12/07/15 into the early morning hours of 12/08/15. I asked Jill if she had any documentation of Jenny's employment at the tavern, and she replied, "No." She only paid Jenny cash, and Jill did not have any payroll slips or further documentation for Jenny. Jill believed Jenny was a licensed bartender, but she did not have any documentation of Jenny's bartending license number from the City of West Allis.

Jill mentioned Jenny previously worked as a bartender at Jilly Beans, located at 9524 W. Greenfield Ave., in 2013. Jenny was let go from Jilly Beans, and Jill later hired Jenny as a cleaner at J. Beans Pub in the fall of 2013. She

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eventually hired Jenny as a bartender at J. Beans Pub, and Jenny was scheduled to work one Sunday night a week from 2000 hours to 0200 hours. Jill paid Jenny \$6.00 per hour, and Jenny usually earned \$36.00 for each of her scheduled shifts. She believed Jenny worked as a bartender at the tavern for approximately one year.

Jill stated she did not know Jenny's last name, and she no longer had Jenny's telephone number. Jill noted that Jenny was "hard to get a hold of." She asked a few customers if they knew Jenny's last name, and none of the customers knew Jenny's last name either. Jill added that she recently changed her telephone number, and she lost all of her contacts. She used to have Jenny's original job application, which contained Jenny's address and telephone number, but Jill said she threw out the only copy of Jenny's job application when Jenny was fired from J. Beans Pub toward the end of December. I asked Jill if she has any record of the work schedules from December 2014, and she replied, "No." Jill stated she wrote out the work schedule for the month of December on a single piece of paper, and she threw the schedule away in the middle of the month. I then asked Jill if she kept electronic copies of her work schedules, and she replied, "No." Jill added she only keeps a paper copy of the work schedules, which are later thrown out, and she does not have a back up system.

I asked Jill to describe Jenny for me. She described Jenny as a white female, approximately 40 to 47 years old, approximately 4 ft. 11 in. tall, thin build, with short blonde hair and glasses. (Note: This description matches the physical characteristics of Jennifer Rodriguez) I then asked Jill if she would be able to identify Jenny in a photograph, and she replied, "Yes." I proceeded to show a WAPD booking photograph, with Jennifer Rodriguez's personal information concealed, to Jill. Jill positively identified the female party pictured in the photograph, Jennifer Rodriguez, as the bartender she knew as "Jenny." She believed Jenny was working the evening of 12/07/14, and Jenny was alone that evening inside the tavern.

Jill advised me that she was being cooperative as possible, and she really had no further information that she could provide to me about Jenny at this time. Jill stated she will speak with the other bar owner, Jason Powelski, and see if he has Jenny's telephone number or address. I advised Jill to contact me at the station with any information for Jenny, and Jill advised me that she still has my business card.

ATTEMPTED CONTACT AT 8515 W HAYES AVE:

On 02/20/15 at approximately 1815 hours, Detective Mees and I responded to the residence located at 8515 W. Hayes Ave., in an attempt to make contact with Jennifer Rodriquez.

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Upon arrival, I observed the lights were off inside the residence. I knocked on the door several times, but there was no answer. I also observed the business card, which I left for Jennifer Rodriguez, was still in the front door.

EMAIL RECEIVED FROM WEST ALLIS CITY HALL:

On 02/23/15, I received an email at the station from Monica Schultz, City Clerk for the City of West Allis. Monica advised me Jennifer Rodriguez does not have a bartender license issued to her. Jennifer Rodriguez's last voting address is listed as 8515 W. Hayes Ave.

TELEPHONE CONTACT WITH ALLEN MEYER:

On 02/23/15 at approximately 1900 hours, I attempted telephone contact with Allen Meyer at telephone number (414) 870-0451.

I asked Allen if he would be able to identify the bartender "Jenny," if I showed him a photograph of her. Allen advised me that he does not personally know the bartender "Jenny," he has never met her, and Allen does not even know what she looks like.

Allen stated his sister Stephanie Meyer, telephone number (414) 335-7352, may be able to identify the bartender. He mentioned Stephanie does not frequent J. Beans Pub a lot, but she is friends with the tavern owner.

I then asked Allen if he knew any information for the bartender Jenny. Allen said he heard that Jenny is older, she used to be a cleaner at the business, and Jenny was let go from the tavern. He further added that people associated with J. Beans Pub were being "tight lipped," because they are afraid that I (reporting detective) will shut the bar down. I asked Allen where he received this information from, and Allen replied, "General bar patrons."

I advised Allen to contact me at the station if he had any additional information regarding this incident.

At approximately 1930 hours, I received a voicemail message from Allen Meyer at the station. Allen said he spoke with his sister Stephanie Meyer, and she may be able to identify the bartender "Jenny" in a photograph. He added that Stephanie does not know the bartender's contact information, but Stephanie heard she (the bartender Jenny) "has a record."

TELEPHONE MESSAGE RECEIVED FROM BRUCE VANDERBUNT:

On 02/24/15 at approximately 1600 hours, I received a telephone message at the station from Bruce Vanderbunt, the father of Jennifer Rodriguez. Bruce

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advised me that Jennifer does not live at the residence, 8515 W. Hayes Ave., and he asked that I call him back at (414) 217-9572.

STATEMENT OF CONTACT: BRUCE VANDERBUNT:

On 02/24/15 at approximately 1630 hours, I made telephone contact with Bruce Vanderbunt at telephone number (414) 217-9572.

Bruce advised me that he is the father of Jennifer Rodriguez, and she has not lived at the residence, 8515 W. Hayes Ave., since 2008. He was on vacation for the past two weeks, and Bruce only received my business card this afternoon. Bruce had contact with Jennifer one time within the last eight months, and Bruce last heard that Jennifer was staying with her friend "Nick" in the City of Milwaukee.

He provided me with Jennifer's cellular telephone number of (414) 477-1491. I advised Bruce to have Jennifer contact me at the station.

ATTEMPTED TELEPHONE CONTACT WITH JENNIFER RODRIGUEZ:

On 02/24/15 at approximately 1700 hours, I attempted telephone contact with Jennifer Rodriguez at telephone number (414) 477-1491.

I made contact with a female party verbally identified as Jennifer Rodriguez. Jennifer advised me she quit working at J. Beans Pub between September or October 2014, and she was not working the evening of 12/07/14. Jennifer stated she spoke with tavern owner Jason Powelski, and Jason told Jennifer that she was "for sure" not working that evening. She did not know who was the employee working the evening of 12/07/14.

At 1715 hours, I attempted telephone contact with Jennifer Rodriguez again. There was no answer, and I left a message advising Jennifer to contact me at the station. I advised Jennifer that I need to speak with her in person, so I can confirm her employment history at the tavern.

FOLLOW UP INVESTIGATION: 9033 W NATIONAL AVE:

On 02/24/15 at approximately 1815 hours, Officer Clark and I responded to J. Beans Pub, 9033 W. National Ave., for follow up investigation.

Upon arrival, I made contact with a female employee behind the bar. I asked if Jill was available, and she advised me Jill will be coming into work at 2000 hours. I then inquired about the work schedule from the month of December. The employee stated Jill is the only party that makes out the work schedule, but the schedule from December 2014 is gone.

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At approximately 2100 hours, Officer Clark and I responded back to J. Beans Pub, 9033 W. National Ave., for follow up investigation.

Upon arrival, I made contact with tavern owner Jill Lisowski inside the business.

THIRD STATEMENT OF CONTACT: JILL LISOWSKI:

I asked Jill if she could confirm if the bartender "Jenny" (Jennifer Rodriguez) was working the evening of 12/07/14. Jill stated she was not 100 percent sure which bartender was working that evening, but Jenny was who came to her mind. Jill did not have a record of when Jenny was let go from the tavern, and she did not know the exact date. She believed Jenny may have been let go in December 2014, but it could have been earlier in the year.

I then asked Jill if she watched the video surveillance footage of Glenn Meyer inside the tavern on 12/07/14. Jill said she did not personally watch the video, but she heard about the video from Jason Powelski last month. I asked Jill what Jason said to her about the video, and Jason told Jill that Stephanie's stepfather slipped and fell. Jill was not sure if Jason watched the video or not, and she did not know who else could have watched the video surveillance footage. She added the video surveillance footage was deleted two weeks later.

Jill stated she did not have any contact information for Jennifer Rodriguez, and she no longer had the work schedule from December 2014. I then asked Jill about Jennifer M. Buckman and Jennifer J. Shallow, who are both listed as licensed bartenders at 9033 W. National Ave. Jill did not recognize the name "Jennifer Buckman" as an employee at J. Beans Pub, and Jill noted Jennifer Shallow works as a bartender every other Saturday from 1200 hours to 2000 hours.

She did provide me with the following employee list, which was written on an index card, and kept behind the bar:

FOLLOW UP INVESTIGATION: 15201 W ROGERS DR:

On 02/24/15 at approximately 2150 hours, Officer Clark and I responded to the residence located at 15201 W. Rogers Dr., in the City of New Berlin, for follow up investigation.

Upon arrival, I made contact with tavern owner Jason Powelski inside the residence.

SECONDARY STATEMENT OF CONTACT: JASON POWELSKI:

I asked Jason if he could tell me who was the bartender that served Glenn Meyer the evening of 12/07/14 into the early morning hours of 12/08/14. Jason stated he was not sure who was working the evening of 12/07/14, and Jill Lisowski makes out the monthly schedule. He noted Jill keeps the schedule on a piece of paper, and there is no electronic backup of the schedule. Jason noted he has spoken to Jill about keeping a more efficient documentation system of the hours worked by their employees.

Jason believed Glenn consumed between four to six bottles of beer that evening, he was by himself, and Glenn did not consume any shots of alcohol. Jason added he has watched video surveillance footage from other incidents inside the bar, and he can tell when a patron is "slamming" beer. He did not observe anything "out of the ordinary" with Glenn's behavior inside the tavern. Jason noted Glenn left the tavern between 0130 hours to 0200 hours. He was contacted by Glenn's stepdaughter Stephanie, and Stephanie asked Jason to review the video surveillance footage so hospital staff at Froedtert Hospital had an idea of the time frame from when Glenn left the tavern to when he possibly fell.

Jason was not sure if Jenny (Jennifer Rodriguez) was working the evening of 12/07/14, or if Jenny was even employed at the tavern on 12/07/14. Jason stated he fired Jenny twice, once this past summer when she stopped showing up for work. He hired Jenny back, and Jason fired Jenny a second time between November or December of 2014 when she stopped showing up for work. Jason did not know the exact date when Jenny was let go.

Jason hired Jenny as a cleaner, and she was paid \$10.00 per hour to clean. She was later hired as a bartender, and Jenny would bartend one night a week. He paid Jenny cash, and she earned \$7.00 per hour as a bartender. Jason did not have a telephone number for Jenny.

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I asked Jason when he last spoke to Jenny, and he believed it was last month around a Packer game after Jenny was fired from the tavern. He had contact with Jenny inside J. Beans Pub, and Jenny told Jason that she was living on the north side of Milwaukee and she recently got jumped while walking home. Jason added that Jenny was arrested by WAPD earlier in 2014 while she was cleaning the tavern. She provided an alias to officers, and Jenny had outstanding warrants for her arrest.

Jason denied having a telephone conversation with Jenny recently, and he also denied telling Jenny that she was "for sure" not working the evening of 12/07/14.

I provided Jason with my business card, and I advised him to contact me at the station if he learns any additional information of which employee may have been working the evening of 12/07/14.

TELEPHONE CALL RECEIVED FROM TAVERN OWNER: JASON POWELSKI:

On 02/25/15 at approximately 1725 hours, I received a telephone call from tavern owner Jason Powelski at the station. Jason indicated that he has received complaints from a few tavern patrons about police officers being inside J. Beans Pub, and it is affecting his business. Jason mentioned he knows that I am doing my job, but my presence at the tavern is drawing negative attention from patrons.

Jason offered to send out a mass text message to all of his bartenders, to see who was working the evening of 12/07/14 to the early morning hours of 12/08/14. He will contact me at the station of the results, and if he is able to identify the bartender that worked the evening of 12/07/14.

TELEPHONE MESSAGE / CONTACT WITH JASON POWELSKI:

On 02/27/15 at approximately 1640 hours, I received a telephone message at the station from Jason Powelski. Jason stated he had some information for me, and I can contact him at telephone number (414) 491-1102.

At approximately 1645 hours, I made telephone contact with Jason Powelski at telephone number (414) 491-1102. Jason said he sent a text message out to all of his bartenders, and he was able to determine that a bartender named "Courtney Boehler" was working the evening of 12/07/14. He provided me with Courtney's telephone number of (414) 364-2422.

Jason added he was told that Jennifer Rodriguez was at J. Beans Pub that evening with Courtney, but Jennifer was not working.

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Jason stated that he was also heard through other bartenders that Allen Meyer may have gone to the Walleye Saloon, located at 8824 W. Becher St., after he left J. Beans Pub during the early morning hours of 12/08/14.

ATTEMPTED TELEPHONE CONTACT WITH COURTNEY BOEHLER:

On 02/27/15 at approximately 2035 hours, I attempted telephone contact with Courtney Boehler at telephone number (414) 364-2422.

There was no answer, and I left a telephone message advising Courtney to contact me at the station regarding this incident.

Note: A search of WAPD Phoenix records revealed a Courtney B. Boehler, F/W, 02/11/85, resides at 9230 W. Hayes Ave.

TELEPHONE MESSAGE RECEIVED FROM COURTNEY BOEHLER:

Beans Pub, but she was not sure when Jennifer was let go from the tavern.

Courtney confirmed she was the only employee tending bar at J. Beans Pub the evening of 12/07/14, and she was by herself. Courtney did not remember any problems inside the tavern that evening, and she remarked it was a "regular Sunday night." I asked Courtney a second time if she remembered Glenn Meyer being inside J. Beans Pub that evening, and she replied, "I cannot say for sure."



INITIAL CALL FOR SERVICE

On 03/19/15 at 1602hrs, officers flagged down at Las Palmas (6007 W. Burnham St.) for a report of a theft.

CONTACT WITH STEVEN P. POWERS

I made contact with Steven P. Powers (m/w, 08/22/62), who stated he had \$100 stolen from him as he was drinking alcohol at with a party known to him only by "Tony." I asked Powers to tell me what happened, and he stated he met Tony at Staffworks earlier in the day, and he invited Tony to go drinking with him. I asked Powers if he had ever met Tony prior to today, and he said no. Powers stated he and Tony visited several bars before ending up at Las Palmas around 1330 hrs on 03/19/15.

Powers stated he and Tony drank for a few hours, and sometime around 1515-1520hrs, Powers fell asleep while sitting at the bar. Powers stated prior to falling asleep, he had placed a \$100 bill on the bar in front of him. When he awoke a few minutes later, Powers realized Tony was gone and he had taken his \$100 bill. Powers exited the business and flagged down Sgt. Pasdera near the intersection of W. Burnham St./S. 60 St. Powers also stated he found a cell phone on the bar that he believed belonged to Tony.

Powers stated Tony was approximately 5'9" - 5'11", medium build, approximately 35-45 yoa, with short, reddish hair. Tony was wearing a blue hooded sweatshirt when last seen by Powers.

Sgt. Pasdera informed me that he viewed the video of the incident from inside Las Palmas, and it did show the victim and the offender sitting together. The video also showed the offender grab an unknown item off of the bar before leaving. However, he stated the video quality was so poor that facial recognition of either party would not be possible. Sgt. Pasdera also informed me that the bartender at the time stated he did not know Tony or the victim.

Looking in the phone that was possibly left behind by Tony, I obtained a possible phone number associated with the phone. I subsequently searched Phoenix to see if we had any contacts with that phone number, but no results were found.

LACK OF CONSENT

At no time did Powers give Tony consent to steal his \$100.



I moved towards Johnson and using heavy control talk, ordered Johnson to get on the ground. Johnson just stood there looking at me. I grabbed Johnson by the left arm and directed him to the ground while controlling his decent. While on the ground, Johnson was handcuffed and searched. A folding knife with a black handle and steel blade was found in Johnson's front right jeans pocket. Johnson was then detained for further investigation. Johnson was placed in a squad and transported to the station for the booking process.

On Johnson's person was his WI/ID Card. A search of Johnson through NCIC revealed he has two final commitments through our department.

I remained on scene to take the statement of the caller.

While holding the knife, Johnson again stated he just got out of jail and he did not give a shit. Michael yelled he was going to call the cops at which point Johnson exited the bar with another known female, Lynnette S. Oelke. The two walked westbound on W Walker St and Michael followed, giving updated information to WAPD dispatch who he was now on the phone with.

ON SCENE STATEMENT - ERIC G. MILLARD - WITNESS

Eric G. Millard, M/W, 03/24/84, stated Oelke and Johnson entered Guzzlers, 7408 W. Walker St., as well as another party which Millard would only refer to as 'Tommy'. Millard stated Oelke and Tommy had a previous history of getting upset with each other. On this particular night, Oelke and Tommy were getting along for a short amount of time and eventually a verbal argument began between Oelke and Tommy.

Millard stated Oelke began the verbal argument with Tommy and things began to escalate, but remained verbal. Millard stated he was able to get the parties separated and brought Oelke and Johnson outside to have a cigarette. While outside, Johnson appeared visibly upset by the verbal argument between Oelke and Tommy. Johnson stated, "I just got out of jail. I have a knife and I'm going to do what I'm going to do".

Oelke, Johnson and Millard returned inside and another verbal argument began between Oelke and Tommy. Tommy left Guzzlers and walked across the street to the Walk Her Inn, 900 S. 74 St. in an attempt to avoid further confrontation. Millard called the main bartender at Walk Her Inn and advised her that Tommy was on his way over and was involved in an argument with Oelke.

Shortly after, Johnson and Oelke exited Guzzlers and began to walk towards the Walk Her Inn. Millard, Joseph V. Vallance, M/W, 04/28/82, and another Guzzlers employee followed Johnson and Oelke to the other bar. Millard

observed Johnson with his right hand in his right front pants pocket while walking to the other bar.

Oelke and Johnson entered the bar with Millard, Vallance, and the other Guzzlers employee following. A verbal argument ensued between Oelke and Tommy at the Walk Her Inn and Millard went to the back room of the bar to speak with the owner and inform them of the situation. INITIAL CALL FOR SERVICE

On 03/21/2015 at 2200hrs, Officers responded to 900 S 74 St, Walker her Inn, for a report of a weapons call, in regards to a male with a knife involved in a fight. I arrived on scene and spoke with Joseph V. Vallone M/W 04/28/1982.

CONTACT WITH JOSEPH V VALLONE - WITNESS

Vallone stated he was at Guzzler's bar, having some drinks with friends. Vallone stated a male, later identified as Antonio L. Johnson, M/W, 11/27/1984, and Lynnette S. Oelke, F/W, 02/02/1973, entered the bar at approximately 1900hrs and where being loud. He stated Oelke walked up to a male named "Tommy" and began arguing with him. Vallone stated the arguement had to do with something that had occurred on St. Patrick's day. Vallone stated Tommy, tried to diffuse the situation but Oelke would not back down.

Vallone stated Tommy tried to walk away from Oelke but she began to follow him. He also stated Johnson began to get in Tommy's face as well. Vallone stated Tommy tried to leave the bar and Johnson and Oelke followed him onto the porch. While on the porch, Vallone heard Johnson say, "Im going to knife you." Johnson also stated, "I just got out of jail."

Based on Johnson's statements and the escelation of the argument, Vallone and his freinds, including Tommy ran across the street to Walk Her Inn. Vallone stated once they entered the bar and walked to the end of it, Johnson entered the bar. Vallone stated Johnson began to walk toward Tommy, with his hands in his pockets. As he approached Tommy, Johnson pulled a knife from his right

pocket. Vallone stated it was a black handled folding knife, with the blade being approximately 3 inches in length. Vallone stated he pushed Tommy away from Johnson. Vallone stated the bartender tried to diffuse the situation.

I asked Vallone if he has ever seen Johnson before or if he knew his name and he stated no. Vallone was able to identify Johnson as a white male, approximately 5'09" with a tattoo on his neck saying "Antonino."

APPREHENSION OF ANTONIO K. JOHNSON

On 03/21/15, at approximately 2200 hrs, I responded with several other officers to the Walk Her Inn tavern, 900 S 74 St, for a complaint of subjects fighting. Dispatch advised one of the subjects was armed with a knife. Upon arrival, officers discovered the male subject with the knife had fled the area and a witness told Officer Primising he was last seen running S/B in the alley from W Walker St, between S 74 St and S 75 St. The information dispatch received was that the subject was an intoxicated white male subject wearing a gray hoody.

While officers were checking the area, Officer Luedke advised she had a male subject in the alley between S 74 St and S 75 St. I responded to her location and observed her standing over a male subject, later identified as Antonio K. Johnson, M/W 11/27/84. Johnson was lying on his stomach next to the garage at 908 S 75 St, and along a chain-link fence. Johnson matched the description of the subject in question and I immediately detained him in handcuffs.

I asked Johnson if he had any weapons on him, including a knife, and he stated he did not. I searched Johnson's person and located a folding knife in his front left pants pocket, which I turned over to Officer Kwasinski. Johnson did not have any additional weapons on his person and he was secured in the back of a squad car.

STATEMENT OF REBECCA A. JENSEN

I responded to the Walk Her Inn and made contact with the bartender, Rebecca A. Jensen, F/W 03/08/80. I asked Jensen what happened at the tavern and she stated she had received a phone call from Eric G. Millard, M/W 03/24/84, who

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owns Guzzler's tavern at 7408 W Walker St. Millard told her there had been an altercation at his tavern involving Tommy A. Velasquez, M/W 01/31/67, and a male and female subject. Millard advised Velasquez was not the problem but that the male and female were. He advised both of the subjects were outside of her tavern (Walker Inn), and he would come over there if they entered to ensure the altercation would not continue.

Jensen stated Velasquez entered her tavern and the male and female subjects followed shortly thereafter. The subjects, later identified as Antonio Johnson and Lynnette S. Oelke, F/W 02/02/73, immediately began arguing with Velasquez and she heard Johnson state, "I'm gonna beat your ass!" Millard entered the tavern and tried to diffuse the situation. Johnson and Oelke began arguing with Millard, and Johnson walked away and entered the men's bathroom.

According to Jensen, Johnson emerged from the bathroom a short time later and she observed him "flick" the blade of a pocket knife open. He was holding the knife in his hands and other bar patrons lunged towards Johnson to control him and prevent a possible attack or stabbing from occurring. She does not remember if Johnson said anything while holding the knife open, but he had opened it and held it in a threatening manner. Millard immediately called to report the incident to the police. As soon as Johnson realized the police had been contacted, he ran out of the tavern and Oelke followed behind him approximately 30 seconds later.

During my contact with Jensen, it was obvious she was distraught and scared as a result of the incident. She advised that Johnson and Oelke were the only problems at the tavern and everyone else tried to walk away or diffuse the situation. She did not see anyone physically assaulting or hitting anyone during the incident, and she did not know the actual identities of the Johnson or Oelke.

Jensen could not provide me with any additional information.

INITIAL CONTACT WITH LYNNETTE S OELKE - OFFENDER

On 03/21/15 at approx 2200hrs, officers were dispatched to the area of W Walker St and S 74 St for a report of a fight involving a male with a knife. While on the way to the call, dispatch advised the male with the knife was walking westbound on W Walker St and was with a female wearing all black. Upon arrival, parties in the street informed me the female involved was standing on the south east corner of S 75 St and W Walker St. I observed a white female with short heair wearing a black sweatshirt standing on the corner. I exited my squad and instructed her to keep her hands up above her head. Based upon the report of a possible weapon involved, she was detained in handcuffs for officer safety purposes. A frisk search was conducted and no

weapons were found.

I informed Oelke she was not under arrest, but simply being detained. I asked her to tell me what happened. While speaking with Oelke, her eyes were glassy and her speech was thick and slurred. I could detect the odor of ingested intoxicants emanating from her breath. She appeared to be intoxicated by alcohol.

Oelke stated she had been drinking at Guzzlers bar with a large group of friends to watch the NCAA tournement games. At an unknown time, she and a friend, later identified as Antonio K Johnson, M/W 11/27/84, went to the Walk Her Inn at 900 S 74 St. While there she stated they ordered a beer and a shot when a male she called "Tony" punched her in the face before she and Johnson exited the bar. She stated she knew "Tony" previously from seeing him at the bar. She stated she did not know anything about a knife and stated she did not fight anyone at the bar.

She was not able to provide me any additional information regarding the identity of "Tony."

ON-SCENE STATEMENT OF TOMMY A VELASQUEZ - WITNESS

I also responded to the Walk Her Inn to speak with witnesses in the bar. While at the bar, I spoke with Tommy A Velasquez, M/W 01/31/67. Velazquez stated he was drinking at the bar when a female he knew as "Shea", later identified as Oelke, entered the bar. He described her as a white female with all black and short hair. He stated he previously knew her from an argument thay had a week prior. He stated she entered the bar and ordered a drink. He advised he Oelke began to verbally argue while in the bar, but the incident did not get physical.

Valasquez stated he eventually walked away because he did not want to argue with Oelke further as she "was way to drunk." HE stated he later heard about a male with a knife, but stated he did not see the knife directly.

TRANSPORT

Oelke was secured in the rear of squad 1 and transported to the station for booking.

IN-CUSTODY STATEMENT OF LYNNETTE S OELKE - OFFENDER

On 03/21/15 at approx. 2327hrs, while in Interview Room B of the West Allis Police Department, I read Oelke her Miranda Warnings off Department Directive 42.016. NARRATIVE

Officer Said reports:

INITIAL OBSERVATIONS

On 3-22-15 at approximately 0051 hrs Squad 313 responded to the tavern, Kip's Inn, 837 S 108 St., for a report of fight that was taking place just outside the tavern. Upon arrival on scene all the parties involved in the fighting were already in custody and I was asked to take custody of one of the participants in the fight, later identified as Daniel B. Bergman (m/w, 9-7-78).

ON SCRNE CONTACT WITH OFFENDER - DANIEL B. BERGEMAN (M/W. 9-7-78)

I immediately noticed upon making contact with Bergeman that he had the odor of intoxicants on his breath, his eyes were both red and glassy and his speech was both slow and slurred.

Bergeman stated he was at the tavern because he was part of a fund raiser that was taking place at the tavern, which began earlier in the day. Bergeman said while inside the tavern a male, later identified as Christopher Bacon, who he had never seen before came up to him and began to touch him and act inappropriately to him. Bergeman said it got out of hand when his girlfriend was yelling at Bacon and the male put his hand down the rear of Bergeman's pants, under his underwear, touching his bare butt. Bergeman said he put his finger in his anus. Bergeman said he told

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Bacon to leave. Then, when Bergeman was leaving the bar, Bacon came from behind a dumpster for Bergeman and tried to attack him.

Bergeman said "What would you do, you are a guy? What would you do if someone did that to you?"

I told Bergeman he should have called the police and Bergeman said that he was too embarrassed to call about something like this.

Bergeman said that once he was outside, he was with his brother (twin brother) David Bergeman, and they both began fighting with the man out of self defense.

Both David and his girlfriend Janine were seated approximately three to four barstools away from where Bergeman was seated when he was allegedly approached and touched by Bacon. Both parties stated that they did not witness any interaction between Bacon and Bergeman, but they did see Bergeman yelling at someone across the bar. (This was later determined to be his brother.) They could not say if there was any touching between Bergeman and Bacon at anytime.

David and Janine both then came outside and tried to help Bacon and break up the fight. They stated that they had nothing further to add.

INTERVIEW WITH OFFENDER - DANIEL B. BERGEMAN (m/w, 9-7-78)

On 3-21-15 at approximately 0218 hrs., I interviewed Daniel B. Bergeman in Interview Room B of the WAPD booking room. I read Daniel his/her Miranda rights from WAPD Directive 42.016 (adult), and he stated he understood his rights and would speak to me about this matter without an attorney present. The interview

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was recorded on an Olympus DS-2200 Digital Voice Recorder (Recorder# P18), using audio media card# P18-2. The following is a synopsis of that interview:

Daniel B. Bergeman initially stated that he did not wish to make any statements then began making the following statements:

Daniel B. Bergeman stated he was at the tavern from approximately 1pm on 3-21-15, when he brought chili to the fund raiser that was being held at the tavern this day. Bergeman said the benefit was for a friend that was sick and found out that his wife was also ill at the same time. Bargeman said that because it was a fund raiser he was not drinking until approximately 5-6 pm.

Bergeman said he was seated at the bar and the male, that was later identified as Bacon, came to where he was seated and put his hands on Bergeman's back and shoulders and began rubbing his back. Bargeman said that he felt very uncomfortable and even Bergeman's girlfriend told the male, Bacon, to stop.

Bergeman said at this time that he recalled that Bacon's hands went down his back and he felt his hand under his pants. I asked if Bacon put his finger in his anus as he had stated to me on scene. He said that he did not know he just believed that his hand went inside his under wear while he was seated on the bar stool.

Bergeman said that he looked at his girlfriend and told her that he felt uncomfortable. The bar owner then came over and told Bacon to leave. Bergeman said that Bacon left, but he just went outside and waited for him. Bergeman said while he left he was attacked by Bacon and he feared for his safety.

I asked Bergeman why he did not call the police and he said that he is a man and did not feel comfortable calling the police about this.

Interview ended at approximately 0228 hrs.

The audio media card was later sealed in a Digital Media Card Envelope, and placed in the Digital Media Card Slot in the Forensic and Technical Services Bureau as evidence.

ARREST DECISION

Due to the fact that all parties (Daniel B. Bergeman; David A. Bergeman; and Christopher A. Bacon) were highly intoxicated, fought outside together not making any attempt to call the police or leave the fight, creating a disturbance outside the tavern, Kip's Inn, 837 S 108 St, all parties were arrested for Disorderly Conduct and issued Municipal Citations.

There was no arrest made for Christopher Bacon's actions inside the tavern due to Daniel's statements being inconsistent as to the exact nature of the contact, there being no other witnesses able to substantiate Daniel's claims and the fact

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that Daniel made no attempt to report these events until in police custody.

FURTHER INVESTIGATION

BOOKING AND TRANSPORT / CITATION ISSUANCE

I transported Daniel Bergeman in the rear of my squad car to the WAPD Booking Room where he was fingerprinted, photographed and processed for Disorderly Conduct.

CASE DISPOSITION

All three parties (Daniel B. Bergeman; David A. Bergeman; and Christopher A. Bacon) were arrested and cited for Disorderly Conduct, issued municipal citations and released.

NARRATIVE

On 03/22/15 at approximately 0051hrs, officers responded to Kips Inn, 837 S 108 St, for a report of individuals fighting. Upon arrival I spoke with offender, Christopher A. Bacon (M/W 02/19/85).

OFFENDER STATEMENT - CHRISTOPHER A. BACON

I located Christopher sitting on a picnic bench outside of Kips Inn. Christopher was identified by WI DL. I observed Christopher had a bloodied mouth and abrasion to his forehead. I proceeded to speak with Christopher.

Christopher explained he was at Kips Inn where he had a few words with an M/W wearing a plad shirt, later identified as Daniel A. Bergeman (M/W 09/07/78). Christopher advised he did not know Daniel. Christopher stated he left Kips Inn and walked west on W Walker St to S 109 St. Christopher told me he then walked back towards Kips Inn where Daniel tackled him to the ground, got on top of him, and punched Christopher 3 - 4 times. Christopher said Daniel stopped striking him when several other individuals pulled Daniel off of him.

I asked Christopher what provoked the fight and Christopher initially indicated Daniel attached him unprovoked. After speaking with other officers on scene who were taking statements from other individuals, it was brought to my attention Christopher touched Daniel on the rear end which provoked the physical altercation.

Christopher admitted to slapping Daniel on the rear end. Christopher told me the touching of Daniel's rear end was like individuals do in sports when they say "Good game."

During my contact with Christopher I detected a strong odor of intoxicants emitting from Christopher's breath, noticed his red and glassy eyes, and Christopher was unstable on his feet. Christopher admitted to being intoxicated. Based on my training and experience I believed Christopher to be intoxicated.

INJURIES

Christopher had a contusion and abrasion to his forehead. Christopher was bleeding from his mouth and suffered a laceration to the bottom right side of his lip which was completely punctured through. Christopher complained of jaw pain. Christopher was asked if he wanted medical attention multiple times during my contact with him and Christopher denied any medical attention.

CALL FOR SERVICE

On 03/22/15 at approximately 0051 hrs, officers were dispatched to a 911 call from Kips Inn, 837 S. 108 St. While squads were en route, further information was provided that a physical altercation was taking place.

OFFICER OBSERVATIONS

I arrived in the area and observed a group of approximately six (6) people in the street on the south side of the establishment. I activated the emergency lights of my WAPD squad and parked away from the crowd. I approached the group, and I overheard several parties shouting something to the effect of, "over there." The parties were pointing at two parties, later identified as David A. Bergeman (m/w, 09/07/78) and Daniel B. Bergeman (m/w, 09/07/78), who were walking westbound on W. Walker St. I ordered both parties, David and Daniel, to put their hands on their head and drop down to their knees, which they complied. I separated the remainder of the crowd from David and Daniel, and I informed them both they were being detained until other squads arrived on scene, as I secured them both in handcuffs without incident.

STATEMENT - DAVID A. BERGEMAN

David stated he was at the bar with his brother, Daniel, along with a small group of friends. At one point in the evening, Daniel walked up to him at the bar and stated something to the effect of, "someone just put their finger up my butt." Daniel pointed out the party, later identified as Christopher A. Bacon (m/w, 02/19/85). David advised he did not observe incident between Christopher and Daniel. David would not elaborate on the events which occurred inside the bar that followed Daniel telling him of the incident.

David advised the party who touched his brother, Christopher, then left the bar for an unknown amount of time. David stated he was with his brother while he was outside smoking a cigarette, when they observed Christopher returning to the bar. When I questioned David on the events that followed Christopher returning to the area outside the bar, David repeatedly stated something to the effect of, "what would you do if someone did that to your brother?" I attempted to obtain any further information from David regarding the events which led to the police being called, but he would not elaborate, as he told

It should be noted that David appeared highly intoxicated while I spoke with him. David's eyes were red and glassy, his speech was thick and slurred, and a strong odor of intoxicants emitted from his person as he spoke.

ARREST DECISION

After speaking with officers on scene, the decision was made that all parties would receive municipal court citations for disorderly conduct. As a result, I informed David he was under arrest for disorderly conduct, and I transported him to the station for processing.

MIRANDA WARNING/INTERVIEW

On 03/22/15 at approximately 0205 hrs, while in Interview Room A of the West Allis Police Department, I read David his Miranda Warnings off Departmental Directive 42.016. David declined to speak with me regarding this incident. This was audio recorded on an Olympus DS-2200 Digital Voice Recorder and saved on a departmental media card (P18-2) and later stored in the Technical and Forensics Bureau.

BOOKING

David was processed under #15-001362, where he received Municipal Court Citation M150013621 for WA-947.01: Disorderly Conduct. David signed the associated PR Bond for the citation, received his copy, and was later released from the station without incident.



STATEMENT - JENNIFER A GERHARTZ (VICTIM):

Jennifer advised she is employed as a bartender at Barneks Tavern and was working in that capacity when this incident allegedly occurred. Jennifer stated she was working inside the bar when a male identified as Michael R Mueller M/W 09/23/1958 came in. She advised Michael was drinking for approximately 1.5 hrs and playing pool with other patrons inside the bar.

COMPLIANCE CHECK OUTLINE

On 03/22/15 from approximately 1700hrs to 1920hrs, I conducted a tobacco compliance check at 13 randomly selected West Allis businesses that have a license to sell tobacco. The check was completed through the use of a 17 year old male, Hunter J. Dziewik, M/W 11/30/97. Dziewik entered each of the randomly selected businesses and attempted to purchase a pack of Newport, or other brand if they did not carry Newports, cigarettes without providing any identification. I advised Dziewik if the sales clerk asked him for identification, he should not question the employee and immediately leave the business.
