Dear Government Official:

Time Warner Cable is committed to providing outstanding customer service and to produce new products of value to our customers.

To that end, Time Warner Cable has been diligently working with local broadcasters to launch HDTV channels on Digital Cable. We added WTMJ HD on channel 504 and WISN HD on channel 512 in November of 2002. We were also pleased to add WDJT HD on channel 505. I am delighted to inform you today that we added **WITI HD on Friday, February 28, 2003 on channel 506 on Time Warner Cable's Digital Broadcast Basic tier**. High Definition channels are available to customers who have a high definition TV **and** a high definition converter (high definition converters are the same price).

On January 30, 2003 we sent you a letter to inform you that Nick Toons will no longer be available on channel 156 as of March 31, 2003. Time Warner Cable will replace Nick Toons with **The Disney Channel's west coast feed**, which will move from channel 192 to channel 156 on **March 31, 2003**.

In addition, Time Warner Cable will also be moving two channels on **May 1, 2003** to more conveniently group our channels for our customers. The Bloomberg Channel will move from channel 103 to channel 105 and the Outdoor Life Network will move from channel 106 to channel 110.

Stay tuned for two new exciting Digital Cable channels we will launch in the very near future! More information regarding the new additions will soon be announced. We are notifying our customers of the many changes taking place through bill notifications and announcements on the cable system including on the TV Guide Channel and The Weather Channel.
