

3. That based upon the facts within the complaint that the License and Health Committee accepted as true on August 22, 2017, and which substantially relates to the licensed activity, Fratelli Restaurant Group, Inc., has failed to make payments for the personal property taxes associated with the business for 2015 and 2016 and is violation of West Allis RMC 7.04(15)(a)6 for failure to pay a tax or forfeiture.

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

1. That the outstanding value of the 2016 personal property taxes for Fratelli Restaurant Group, Inc. was \$1,158.52 as of July of 2017, has continued to accrue interest and penalties since that date, and has not been paid as of the date of this document being drafted.
2. That the outstanding value of the 2015 personal property taxes for Fratelli Restaurant Group, Inc. was \$1,221.97 as of July 2017, has continued to accrue interest and penalties since that date, and has not been paid as of the date of this document being drafted.
3. That the failure to pay personal property taxes as outlined in the Conclusions of Law substantially relates to the licensed activity and function of the city services related to the licensed activity and premises and constitute a sufficient basis to revoke or suspend the “Restaurant-Moderate Complexity” permit under permit number GSAC-9M8LM2.


RECOMMENDATION:

1. Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the “Restaurant-Moderate Complexity” permit under

permit number GSAC-9M8LM2 associated with the premises 6202 W. Lincoln Avenue as issued to Fratelli Restaurant Group Inc., and which expires on June 30, 2018, be revoked.
