

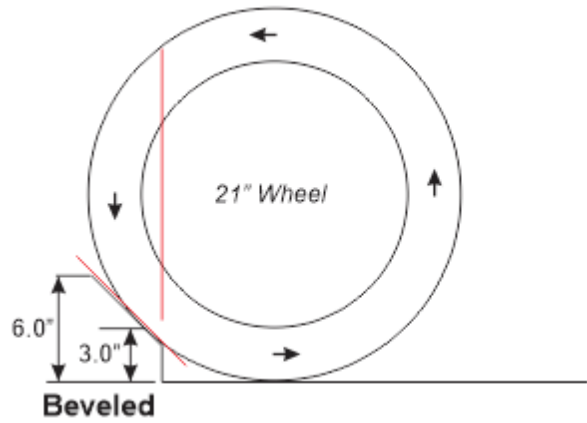

Dear 85th Street Property Owner

85th Street from Washington Street to Greenfield Avenue is scheduled for reconstruction in 2016. You may be aware that a petition was circulated along 85th Street for “mountable” curb (See Below). The City’s standard curb is 6 inches high with a vertical face. The “mountable” curb, because of the beveled curb face, would make parking cars during the State Fair easier.

The Engineering Division was directed to take alternate bids for the “mountable” curb vs. the standard curb to determine if there was a difference in costs. The bids submitted by the lowest responsible contractor revealed a bid price of \$15 per lineal foot for the City’s standard curb and \$16 per lineal foot for the “mountable” curb.

The Board of Public Works directed staff to mail out a waiver form, which is enclosed, which would grant the City legal authority to add the additional cost of the “mountable curb” to the special assessment already mailed out. Your additional cost, if you agree to sign the waiver and mail back in the enclosed self-addressed, stamped envelope is shown on the waiver form.



The Board of Public Works wants to review the results of the mailing at their next meeting on Tuesday, March 15, 2016. Therefore, if you agree with the additional cost, please return your waiver in the self-addressed, stamped envelope to me by Friday, March 11th. Any waivers received after that date may not be counted.
