RE: Settlement Demand - August, 5 2025  
Excessive Force Incident

Dear City Attorney:

- I am writing to resolve a civil rights claim arising from an incident on August 5, 2025 at 6410 W. Moltke Ave Milwaukee, WI 53210

- During execution of a search warrant, I fully complied with officers commands, exited the residence with my hands raised and was placed on my knees and handcuffed. While restrained and not resisting, officer Brockman slammed my head onto concrete, causing a laceration, swelling, and permanent scarring. I was transported to West Allis Hospital for treatment.

- This use of force was objectively unreasonable and violated my rights under the Fourth Amendment to the United States Constitution (42 U.S.C. § 1983).

- This incident was captured on video including body worn camera footage and Ring camera footage

- As a result, I have suffered physical injury, permanent scarring, pain, and emotional & mental distress.

- In officer Brockman Use of Force report he claimed I try to flee and seem as I would cause harm to other officers. Those statements are false. On camera not once did I resist. He claimed to try to use a head tactic police use and lower my head in grass. False I was already kneeled on concrete. There is no way you can mistake that for grass. The police department also failed to review the incident report internally. Also any Dr. will tell you, you would have to apply a lot of force and pressure to leave a big permanent mark on someone's forehead.

- In an effort to resolve this matter without litigation, I am willing to settle all claims against the City of West Allis and its officers for:  
\$ 5,000,000

- However I am willing to settle for less than my initial price. I will settle for:  
\$ 3,100,000

This offer is made in good faith to avoid the costs and risks of litigation. If this matter is not resolved, I have a letter and documents I will send to the DOJ, so they could look into WAPD for violations they may have done over the past few years. I will release the ring camera footage to the NAACP so they can help me with the media because police brutality on Blacks needs to stop and officers who lie need to be punished. I will seek charges against Officer Brockman for assault. I also have prepared and ready to file a federal civil rights lawsuit, and I will seek the full \$5,000,000 and will not take any deal nor will I negotiate.

IF the \$3,100,000 offer is accepted  
I will sign a NDA, and will not pursue  
any of the things I just mentioned in the  
last paragraph. I have all the fatigue and hospital  
records my case is strong, extremely strong.

- please respond within 30 days of  
receipt of this letter.
