Stat. 7.52, the West Allis Board of Absentee Ballot Canvassers shall publicly convene to count all absentee ballots that are received by the city clerk at West Allis City Hall by 8:00 p.m. on election day. Polling places will not accept completed absentee ballots for counting; all completed absentee ballots must be in delivered to City Hall before 8:00 p.m. to be counted.

All incidents occurring during the counting of absentee ballots shall be noted within the incident report for the ward affected.

E. ADJOURNMENT

The board will adjourn at 8:00 p.m., or at such time that all absentee ballots have been canvassed, whichever is later.



All meetings of the West Allis Board of Absentee Ballot Canvassers are public meetings. In order for the general public to make comments at the committee meetings, the individual(s) must be scheduled (as an appearance) with the chair of the committee or the appropriate staff contact; otherwise, the meeting of the committee is a working session for the committee itself, and discussion by those in attendance is limited to committee members, the mayor, other alderpersons, staff and others that may be a party to the matter being discussed.
