RE: Assessor's Office Reorganization

Recently, Mary Hennen an Appraiser II (3/4 time) resigned her position to accept an offer with the City of Milwaukee. This event has led to our need for a minor reorganization in our office. I am requesting that the Appraiser II (3/4 time) position be replaced with an Appraiser I (full time) employee. This position would be filled by promotion of a current staff member. I am seeking to promote an Assessment Clerk I (full time) to this newly created position of Appraiser I. This employee meets all the requirements and certifications for this position.

This promotion will then open up the Assessment Clerk I position. I am requesting that this position be adjusted from full time to ¾ time. This decrease in hours for the Assessment Clerk I position is made possible by the startup of the Webmap / Assessor's internet site. The potential savings to the City by this reorganization plan would be between \$3,000 and \$4,000.

I am herby requesting Council approval of this reorganization plan for the City Assessor's Office.
