Dear Council Members:

The enclosed claim has been referred to this office in accordance with Section 3.05 (6)(a) of the Revised Municipal Code. This office has examined the facts of the claim and the applicable law. Our Opinion regarding liability is as follows:

It is the recommendation of this office that the following claim be denied:

Mark Springfield - Amount: \$878.49

This is a claim for property damages to the claimant's vehicle on April 16th, 2008, when the claimant struck a pothole in the road located at South 76th Street and West Washington Avenue in the City of West Allis, WI. The claim alleges the pothole to be 1½ feet long and 6 feet wide. The claimant allegedly needed three (3) new tires as a result of striking the pothole in question. The claimant obtained two estimates for repair and filed a claim against the City on May 1st, 2008.

Our investigation into this claim indicated that the area where the incident occurred has traverse joint failures in the street, which have been filled with asphalt patch material in the past and is routinely monitored until the resurface of the entire street, which is to take place in 2011. In a case like this involving a defect in the road, the City is only responsible for damages if the City knew about the defect prior to the incident and failed to repair the same in a reasonable amount of time. Here, the City did in fact know about the general condition of the street prior to the claimant's accident; however, by using asphalt patch along with regular monitoring, the City did all it could do to maintain the street absent a total resurfacing, which is unreasonable at this time and actually scheduled for 2011. Therefore, the City was not negligent in this case by attempting to maintain the street in the usual and customary method of repair pursuant to industry's standards, but that said repairs did not hold through the harsh elements of the winter season. This case would be different had the City taken no steps whatsoever to maintain the street once it knew of its general condition.

Based upon the above, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office to deny this claim pursuant to the provisions of Wisconsin Municipal Claims Statute 893.80.




