FAVOR, because the bill would result in police personnel costs savings.

**AB296** ALCOHOL BEVERAGE LICENSES AND PERMITS; REVOCATION

FAVOR, because the bill would greatly expand the City's ability to control drug

activities in taverns.

EMPLOYMENT DISCRIMINATION, WAGE DISPARITIES STUDY **SB130** 

OPPOSE, because the bill would greatly increase the City's potential liability.

However, the study of wage disparities would be desirable.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES; BENEFITS **AB304** 

> OPPOSE until the undesirable portions of the bill are removed; i.e., that all health insurance savings must go to employee wage increases and that police and fire are

excluded. However, the bill does have some other positive aspects.
