An Ordinance to Amend Section 1.021 of the West Allis Revised Municipal Code to redistrict the boundaries of the Aldermanic Districts of the City of West Allis.

The Common Council of the City of West Allis do ordain as follows:

PART I. Section 1.021 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City of West Allis is hereby amended to read:

- 1.021 ALDERMANIC DISTRICTS. The City is divided into five (5) Aldermanic Districts with two (2) Alderpersons from each Aldermanic District elected every four (4) years. All Aldermanic Districts are as compact in area as possible and contain, as nearly as practicable by combining contiguous whole wards, a substantially equal number of inhabitants according to the 2010 Decennial Federal Census of Population.
- (1) First Aldermanic District. The combination of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th wards, as identified and shown on the official Ward Map of this City, shall constitute the First Aldermanic District.
- (2) Second Aldermanic District. The combination of the 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th wards, as identified and shown on the official Ward Map of this City, shall constitute the Second Aldermanic District.
- (3) Third Aldermanic District. The combination of the 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th, and 15th wards, as identified and shown on the official Ward Map of this City, shall constitute the Third Aldermanic District.
- (4) Fourth Aldermanic District. The combination of the 16th, 17th, 18th, 19th, and 20th wards, as identified and shown on the official Ward Map of this City, shall constitute the Fourth Aldermanic District.
- (5) Fifth Aldermanic District. The combination of the 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 24th, and 25th wards, as identified and shown on the official Ward Map of this City, shall constitute the Fifth Aldermanic District.

PART II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

PART III. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
