A major activity during the first quarter were the numerous candidate forum programs produced. The Community Media Center (WACCC) also received recognition through one of its programs, La Cuisine Du Garage, which was covered in one of the Journal Sentinel's Sunday Food Sections.


14 new members joined the WACCC and a total of 65 programs were produced. The West Allis Kiwanis Club, the Slovenian Folk Group and the East Allis Association are going through training at the Community Media Center.

Two fundraising events were held to help augment their operating funds. The first was selling coupons for Boston Store Community Day and the second was a raffle at the Business After Five gathering held at the Community Media Center.

The Executive Director of the WACCC has met with the City's Cable Communications Coordinator to discuss funding for the Community Media Center as it pertains to renewal of the City's Franchise Agreement with Time Warner Cable.

It is staff's recommendation the first quarter operating funds be allocated to the WACCC.
