



NARRATIVE

PO Kaye Reports:

On 10/28/14 at approximately 0100hrs, officers responded to Dopps, 1753 S 68 St, for a bar fight. Upon arrival PO Fletcher and I entered the front door of Dopps and I observed an individual, later identified as Lonny D. Slowey (M/W 02/26/69), lying on the floor near the bar area with an abrasion to his forehead and a scratch to his nose which he was bleeding from. I observed another individual, later identified as Thomas W. Roberts Jr. (M/W 11/21/48), standing near Lonny. PO Fletcher began to speak with Thomas as I assisted Lonny.

OFFENDER STATEMENT - LONNY D. SLOWEY

I asked Lonny what was going on as he was lying on the floor with abrasions/cuts to his face. Lonny told me he had no idea what I was talking about. I asked Lonny if he wanted any medical attention several times and Lonny stated he did

not. I continued to ask Lonny why he and Thomas had been fighting and Lonny denied being in a fight.

During my contact with Lonny I noticed the strong odor of intoxicants emitting from Lonny's breath, his red and glassy eyes, slow and slurred speech, and Lonny unable to maintain his balance while standing. Based on my training and experience I believed Lonny to be under the influence of intoxicants.

Lonny advised officers we could search him. During the search I located \$14.00 cash in Lonny's right cargo pants pocket (The cash Susan indicated Lonny stole from Thomas off the bar). Lonny told me he did not steal any money from Thomas.

OFFENDER STATEMENT - THOMAS W. ROBERTS See PO Fletcher's Supplemental Report.

WITNESS/COMPLAINTANT STATEMENT - SUSAN K. JONES See SGT Kempinski's Supplemental Report.

ARREST DECISION

Based on the fact Thomas and Lonny were involved in a physical altercation inside of Dopps causing a disturbance, both Thomas and Lonny were arrested for Disorderly Conduct.

Based on the fact officers located Thomas's cash in Lonny's pants pocket, Lonny was arrested for Theft.

BOOKING

See PO Fletcher's Supplemental Report.

While at the WAPD I booked and issued Lonny for local Disorderly Conduct and Theft. Lonny signed the Disorderly Conduct citation/PR Bond but refused to sign the Theft citation/PR Bond. Lonny also decided half way through the fingerprint process he did not want to allow me to fingerprint him anymore. Lonny was put in a holding cell and later completed the fingerprint process.

IN CUSTODY STATEMENTS

I did not conduct a In Custody interview on Lonny based on his intoxication level and his uncooperativeness during the booking process.

CASE DISPOSITION

Investigation revealed Lonny D. Slowey (M/W 02/26/69) and Thomas W. Roberts (M/W 10/21/48) where both intoxicated and began to argue over politics, which lead to a physical altercation. Lonny also took \$14.00 cash which belonged to Thomas, which was located on Lonny's person. Thomas was arrested for Disorderly Conduct, and

NARRATIVE

Officer Fletcher reports...

INITIAL RESPONSE

On 10/28/14 at approx. 0100hrs., I responded to Dopp's, 1753 S. 68 St. for a report of two parties actively fighting inside of the tavern. Upon arrival, Officer Kaye and I entered the tavern, where I observed a male party, later identified as Lonny D. Slowey M/W 02/26/69 lying on his back near the bar. I additionally observed a male party, later identified as Thomas W. Roberts Jr. M/W 10/21/48, standing at the bar, bleeding from his left ear and face. I made contact with Roberts and spoke with him outside of the tavern.

STATEMENT OF THOMAS W. ROBERTS JR.

Roberts advised shortly before officers arrived on scene, he was involved in a physical fight inside of the tavern with another male party, later identified as Slowey. Roberts stated he did not know Slowey, and had never met him prior to that evening. The altercation began after Roberts was speaking with another bar patron regarding Roberts' contributions that he makes to various charities for veterans. As Roberts was speaking with the other patron, Slowey began arguing with Roberts stating that he was lying about the contributions that he makes to veterans. Roberts advised Slowey then approached him from behind, and put him in a "headlock." Roberts stated the attack was "totally unprovoked."

After Slowey placed Roberts in a headlock, Roberts pulled Slowey down to the ground to defend himself. Roberts and Slowey proceeded to physically fight on the ground for approx. five minutes. Roberts advised that during the fight, he and Slowey punched each other numerous times in the body and face. During this altercation, Roberts sustained two small lacerations to his left ear and cheek.

After approx. five minutes, Roberts and Slowey stopped fighting, and Roberts walked into the bathroom to clean himself. Roberts then exited the bathroom approx. one minute later, and observed that his cash (approx. \$14.00) had been taken from off of the bar. Roberts believed that Slowey had taken the money when he was inside of the bathroom. When Roberts confronted Slowey about taking his money, the two of them began fighting again, falling to the ground next to the bar. Officers arrived on scene shortly after and separated the parties. When I asked Roberts why he did not separate himself from the altercation and contact police, he advised that "he didn't have time" because

it happened so fast.

LACK OF CONSENT

Roberts did not give Slowey consent to punch him, put him in a headlock, or take his money.

ARREST OF ROBERTS

Based on Roberts' involvement in the altercation, I placed him under arrest for Disorderly Conduct. I subsequently transported Roberts to the station for booking.

INTERVIEW

On 10/28/14 at approx. 0204hrs., while in interview room B of the West Allis Police Department, I read Roberts his Miranda warnings off Departmental Directive 42.016. Roberts declined to speak with me regarding this incident.

BOOKING / RELEASE

Roberts was booked under booking #14-005073 for Disorderly Conduct. Roberts was issued a municipal citation, signed a PR bond, given a municipal court date of 12/01/14 at 0830hrs., and released.

NARRATIVE

Sgt. Kempinski reports...

DISPATCH TO CALL/ARRIVAL ON SCENE

On 10/28/14 at approximately 0100hrs I responded to Dopps (1753 S. 68th St.) for a report of two males physically fighting inside of the bar. When I arrived on scene Officer Kaye and Officer Fletcher had seperated the two males involved. One of the males walked outside the bar with Officer Fletcher and another male remained laying on the bar floor. He was awake and speaking to Officer Kaye but was refusing to stand up.

Officer Kaye asked the male if he wanted an ambulance but he declined one. I then began speaking with the female complainant and bartender, Susan K. Jones (07/18/1967).

STATEMENT OF COMPLAINANT/WITNESS- Susan Kay Jones (07/18/1967)

Jones advised me that she was working at the bar serving drinks and there were only two male parties left in the bar. The two males (later identified as Thomas W. Roberts, M/W, 10/21/1948 and Lonny D. Slowey, M/W, 02/26/1969) began arguing about politics and referencing democrats. As the conversation began getting more heated Lonny walked over to Thomas, who was drinking at the bar, and punched him in the head.

Thomas quickly got up and the two males began pushing and swinging at each other. Jones stated that she intervened and told the males they needed to break it up. They did temporarily, however Lonny then walked up and grabbed Thomas's cash from in front of him off the bar and began walking away. Thomas got up, grabbed Lonny by the neck area, and tackled him to the ground. Jones called 911 as Lonny continued to "choke Lonny out" on the ground.

The police arrived a short time later.
