Thank you for the improved road and traffic management during 2014...Greatly Appreciated.

Petition: North and south bound traffic Stop Signs on 116th. Street at w. Walker Street intersection should be removed. Removal of these Stop Signs will eliminate undue driving stops. Driving north on 116th Street from Greenfield Avenue;

- 1.) We have Stop and Go Lights.
- 2.) A block north at Madison Street intersection, "No Stop Sign for 116th. Street traffic"?
- 3.) A block further north at Washington Street, a Stop Sign.
- 4.) Another Stop Sign one block north at Walker Street, a third Stop.
- 5.) And again one more block north at Theo Trecker Way, another Stop Sign.

Five street blocks in a row and four required traffic driver stops.

My 60 minute walks on 116th. Street include walking north and south of Greenfield Avenue. The Stop Signs on 116th. Street, intersected at Walker Street is excessive required stopping. It is a three way stop intersection and should not warrant 116th. Street drivers to stop. We do not have a Stop Sign on 116th. Including the "Bike, Walk and Run" West Allis Cross Town Connector. And as of to date, we have not had a need for Stop Signs at these intersections.
