
5. That on October 1, 1989; March 14, 1992; March 26, 1998; and October 23, 2012, John Cissa did operate a motor vehicle while under the influence of an intoxicant, contrary to section 346.63(1)(A), Wis. Stats., and was subsequently convicted of said offenses.
6. That the conduct of John Cissa described in paragraph 5 substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensed activity contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(b), so as to disqualify John Cissa from obtaining, keeping, or renewing a Class "I" Operator's License.

WHEREFORE, Michael J. Czaplewski requests that John Cissa be summoned to appear before the License and Health Committee of the West Allis Common Council to answer this complaint and, if the material allegations of the complaint are denied, that a hearing be held to determine whether the Operator's License issued to John Cissa should be suspended, revoked or not renewed.
