Dear Councilmen and Councilwomen,

On March 12, 2018, I requested revocation of a Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection's (DATCP's) food facility/mobile food establishment license called Mister BBQ. This establishment is parked and selling food at 8322 W. Lincoln Avenue in West Allis.

- Sept 7, 2017: West Allis Health Department closed the facility due to unsanitary conditions, no proof of valid service base, and inability to answer basic food safety questions.

- December 7, 2017: Mister BBQ was parked out front of 8322 W Lincoln Ave. The Fire Department conducted an inspection and found the following violations: missing K Class and 2A10BC Extinguishers, extension cords being used as substitute for permanent wiring in truck and extension cord to inside of building, LP Gas not properly secured and stored, gasoline not properly stored, generator not separated from the public, expired State License in window.

- February 8-13, 2018: Mobile unit does not return to service base (located in Milwaukee). Also, owner is using a building located at 8322 W Lincoln Ave, West Allis, WI as service base with no service base license and is also violating their special use permit, etc.

- March 11, 2018: A fire occurred on the Mobile unit, West Allis Fire Department was at scene to extinguish and Jervel Williams (owner) fled the scene before investigation was completed. Also, he would not respond to multiple calls from our police department to return to scene.

In closing, I am also asking that the Food Peddlers license # 2515 for Mister BBQ be revoked immediately to protect the health and safety of the residents of his City, and to ensure the establishment does not operate in West Allis.
