Upon deliberation and consideration of the complaint presented at the License and Health meeting held on October 6, 2015, the Committee finds:

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

1. That Big Dogs Sports Grill, LLC, by registered agent, Gary Jackowski, was properly served a copy of the summons and complaint, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 125.12(2)(ar);
2. That Gary Jackowski failed to appear to contest the complaint and, thus, the allegations in the complaint are considered to be true;
3. That the conduct of Gary Jackowski and Big Dogs Sports Grill, LLC described in the complaint substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensed activity contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.12(2)(ag)1 and West Allis Revised Municipal Code Sections 9.35(1)-(2);
4. That in particular, Big Dogs Sports Grill, LLC's failure to have possession of a premises to conduct its tavern business and closure of its tavern for more than 30 consecutive days is contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.12(2)(ag)1 and West Allis Revised Municipal Code Sections 9.35(1)-(2);


**CONCLUSION OF LAW:**

1. That the foregoing constitutes a sufficient basis to not renew the “Class B” Intoxicating Liquor License and Class “B” Fermented Malt Beverage License of Big Dogs Sports Grill, LLC.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the “Class B” Intoxicating Liquor License and Class “B” Fermented Malt Beverage License of Big Dogs Sports Grill, LLC be revoked and not renewed.
