- AB253** **RECYCLING EFFICIENCY INCENTIVE GRANT; POPULATION OF LOCAL UNIT**
FAVOR, because the bill would enable us to seek further recycling incentive grants without teaming up with one or more cities

FAVOR, because bill would give the City further liability protection. The bill, however, should be amended to repeal section 81.17 to retain special protection when someone else is also responsible for snow or ice.

FAVOR, because the bill would provide help in responding to public health emergencies.
