

**NOTICE OF FUNDING
AVAILABILITY
FIVE DAY PUBLIC COMMENT
PERIOD**

In response to the Coronavirus Pandemic (COVID-19) the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant has notified the City of West Allis that it will receive an allocation of \$762,000 to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus (COVID-19). This allocation was authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136, which was signed by President Trump on March 27, 2020, to respond to the growing effects of this historic public health crisis.

The City of West Allis Department of Development, HUD/CDBG Grant Administration Office, hereby requests public comment from citizens within the community, private for profit enterprises, and not-for-profit organizations for assistance in determining the distribution of the 2020 CARES funding.

\$762,000 will be available for eligible activities meeting the national objective to prevent and respond to the spread of infectious diseases such as the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).

The Five Day Public Comment Period will begin on Friday, April 24, 2020 and conclude on Wednesday, April 29, 2020 at 5:00pm.
