Assistant City Attorney Allison C Childs deposes and states as a complaint under Wis. Stat. § 125.12 and West Allis Code § 9.52 against Hayley Negron as follows:

1. That this complaint is based upon information contained within official records maintained by the City of West Allis and the City of West Allis Police Department that the complainant has used in the past and found to be reliable.

Parties and License Information

2. That the complainant is a resident of the City of West Allis.
3. That Hayley Negron is the current holder of an Operator's License issued pursuant to Wis. Stat. §125.17 under the license number BART-1634 for the period running from December 10, 2025 to June 30, 2027.

Incidents Subject to Complaint

*Count 1: Materially False Application Information – December 9, 2025*

4. That on December 9, 2025, Hayley Negron attended a Public Safety Committee meeting. At this meeting an agenda was called in reference to Item #43 which was a New Operator License Bartender Class C Operator Application for Hayley Negron.
5. At the December 9, 2025, meeting, the council advised Hayley Negron that she has an OWI arrest on her record from June 2024. Hayley corrected the council and stated that the arrest occurred during March 2024. Hayley stated she has complied with everything associated with the arrest.
6. Council then asked Hayley if she has a driver's license at the moment. Hayley responds to council, stating "I do not. I currently get rides right now."
7. An Alderperson then asked Hayley how she got to City Hall, to which Hayley responded, "No" and "I was driven, I Uber'd over." Another Alderperson advised that there are cameras and that if someone was found to be not honest, they could be pulled back in regarding the incident.
8. On January 29, 2026, West Allis Police Department Officer Andrew Lamm was assigned to follow up and verify whether Hayley Negron drove herself to the Common Council meeting at City Hall on December 9, 2025. Officer Lamm checked Hayley's driving status, which showed a revoked status.
9. Officer Lamm's check revealed Hayley was issued an Operating After Revocation citation on December 8, 2025, the day prior to the Public Safety Committee meeting, at which time she was operating a 2013 Nissan Rogue bearing WI License plate number 943-VNA, which is registered to Hayley.
10. Officer Lamm then reviewed the cameras at City Hall, where the council meeting was held. The cameras labeled "CH0Front Door > E" and "CH-Front Door > at 1838

hrs.” show Hayley’s black Nissan SUV entering the parking lot from the west. Officer Lamm reports that the cameras then show the Nissan parking and Hayley emerging from the driver’s side of the vehicle. No other person exits the vehicle, and the vehicle appears to be turned off, due to the running lights being turned off. Hayley then walks into City Hall.

11. Officer Lamm reports that on camera “CH-CSC Lobby,” Hayley is seen walking in wearing the same clothes she is wearing in the council meeting room and is wearing the hat which is placed on the table in front of her during the meeting.
12. Officer Lamm reports that during his video review of the December 9, 2025, meeting, which is viewable on YouTube, Hayley told an Alderman she “was driven” to the meeting.

Violations of State Law and Local Code

13. The statements by Hayley Negron during the Public Safety Committee meeting in response to an Alderman provided materially false application information in connection for her application for a New Operator License Bartender Class C Operator Application in violation of Wis. Stat. 125.04(3)(j) found in Count 1.

**WHEREFORE**, Assistant City Attorney Allison C Childs requests that Hayley Negron be summoned to appear before the Public Safety Committee of the West Allis Common Council to answer this complaint and, if the material allegations of the complaint are denied, that a hearing be held to determine whether the Operator’s License issued to Hayley Negron should be revoked or suspended.
