### NARRATIVE

Officer Lehman reports....

### INITIAL OBSERVATIONS

While on patrol at the corner of S. 63 St and W. National Ave, Officer Beyer and I heard men shouting and a woman screaming. The sound appeared to be coming from inside of "Lenny's Bar" at 6309 W National Ave. As we pulled into the parking lot we were dispatched to the location for a trouble call described by the caller as "a war in the bar." Upon entering the bar I observed, a male party, later identified as Joshua M. Bantz, who had blood on his face/head and shirt. Also in the bar was Leonard E. Malan, the bartender, and Christina J. Bantz, Joshua's mother.

I spoke with Joshua while Officer Sterling spoke with Malan and Officer Cato spoke with Christina.

### STATEMENT FROM JOSHUA M. BANTZ

Joshua said while he was in the bar with his mother, a group of about three or four males were staring him down and whispering while pointing at him. Joshua said he told the parties that if they had a problem with him they should "act like men and say something." A shouting match arose and an unidentified person punched Joshua in the head.

Joshua fell to the ground and three or four guys from the party starting kicking and punching him. While Joshua was lying on the ground he was kicked and punched multiple times in rapid succession. While Joshua was being attacked he felt someone go through his pockets and steal \$400.00.

Joshua said the offenders ran through the backdoors of the bar and drove away prior to officer's arrival.

### DESCRIPTION OF THE OFFENDERS

Joshua described his attackers as being three or four white, or light skinned males. Two of the males had blueish grey sweaters with hoods on and another was

wearing a black sweater. They were all wearing designer blue jeans and three of them had hats on. Two of the males had thin mustaches and one had a long dark brown ponytail with braided hair. Joshua said he saw his attackers drive away in a white Chevy Lumina and a Cavalier of an unknown color. Joshua said he saw them drive away in their cars when he ran out the door after them after they stole his money. Joshua only gave general descriptions of all the parties, he could not give specific individual descriptions.

### LACK OF CONSENT

Joshua M. Bantz did not give anyone permission to hit him and take his money.

### OBSERVATIONS OF INJURIES/MEDICAL ATTENTION

While talking to Joshua I observed abrasions and moderate lacerations on his face/head. His nose appeared red and swollen. There was dried blood on and around his lips. There was fresh blood on his white T-shirt.

An ambulance from the WAFD responded to treat Joshua. Joshua was medically cleared and said he did not need to go to the hospital.

Officer Beyer took pictures of Joshua's injuries. See Officer Beyer's supplemental report.

### CASE DISPOSITION

Officers checked the area, but were unable to locate anyone.

Joshua was given my business card and told to call me if he could recall any additional information.

#### NARRATIVE

### STATEMENT-LEONARD E. MALAN (WITNESS)

Officer B. Sterling reports...

I spoke to the owner of the business, Leonard E. Malan, regarding this incident. Malan was working as the bartender this evening and the only staff on duty.

Malan stated the night was going fine, there were not many people in the tavern. There was a group of about 4-5 males, and a few females in the rear of the business playing pool and having a good time. There was a young male, later identified as Joshua M. Bantz, sitting at the bar with his mother.

Malan stated Bantz kept staring at the large group of males and "running his mouth" at them. Bantz was making comments about gangs and was "mean mugging" them. Malan stated words were eventually exchanged between Bantz and the group of males. Malan told Bantz mother to calm him down or get him out of here before trouble starts.

Malan stated Bantz took off his glasses and stood up abruptly and walked aggressively towards the group of males. Bantz was getting close to the males and a pushing match started.

Malan stated eventually the four males were punching and kicking Bantz. They had him on the ground and were feeling in and around his pockets. Malan thought the males were searching for a weapon. Malan did not see the males remove anything from Bantz. Malan ran towards the altercation and yelled for Bantz mother to call 911. Malan stated he did not have enough time to call himself.

Malan was eventually able to break up the fight and the group of males and females ran out the back door. Malan did not get a vehicle description and there is no video surveillance inside or outside the bar.

Malan described the four suspects as early 20's, all slim builds, one was a light skinned m/b, the others were all male hispanics. Malan could not give any clothing description but thought one of the males wore a gold New York Yankee baseball cap. Malan stated the four suspects have been in the bar before and he would be able to identify them again.

Malan stated he would call the police if the suspects ever came back to the bar.
