## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By orders dated May 31 and June 12, 2013, the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads ordered the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (DOT) and the Union Pacific Railroad Co. (UP) to complete grade-separated crossings of the UP tracks with the public crossings of Interstate 94 (crossing no. 177 257B / MP 89.91) and the Hank Aaron State Trail (HAST) (no crossing number) in the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County.1

By letter dated August 15, 2014, the DOT requested that the OCR clarify the deadlines for two components of the work necessary to complete the project, specifically, the relocation railroad wayside signals and the shifting of the track to allow trains to begin using the new structure.

DOT requested that the OCR order the railroad to complete the relocation of the wayside signals by October 28, 2014 and to complete the track shift between October 28 and November 12, 2014. The DOT and UP entered into a forcework agreement that required DOT to provide the UP with 30 days' notice in advance of the required completion. The DOT's request will provide the railroad with well over the required notice.

## THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED,

- That the Union Pacific Railroad Co. shall complete the relocation of the wayside signals by October 28, 2014 and to complete the track shift between October 28 and November 12, 2014 for the grade-separated crossings of Interstate 94 (crossing no. 177 257B / MP 89.91) and the Hank Aaron State Trail (no crossing number) with its tracks in the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County.
  - 2. That jurisdiction is retained.
