Resolution to approve bid of Payne & Dolan, Inc. for the asphalt resurfacing of the pavement including the cracking and seating of the pavement with miscellaneous driveway and sidewalk repair, sanitary sewer, and utility adjustments in S. 101st St. from W. National Ave. to W. Cleveland Ave.; S. 101st St. from W. Greenfield Ave. to 158' S/O W. Maple St. and S. 100th St. from W. Schlinger Ave. to W. Walker St. in the City of West Allis in the amount of \$845,950.00.

WHEREAS, The Board of Public Works reports that it duly advertised for bids for the furnishing of certain materials and the performance of all work required for the improvements in a certain area as hereinafter described; that the bids received as shown on the attached bid report were reasonable and hereby recommends and deems it to be for the best interests of the City of West Allis that the bid of Payne & Dolan, Inc. for 2014 Project No. 10 be accepted.
