

WHEREAS, Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program regulations require a Public Hearing on the proposed use of Eleven Thousand Twenty-seven Dollars (\$11,027) in federal funding for the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program; and,

WHEREAS, after due notice, a Public Hearing was held on September 21, 2004; and,

WHEREAS, appropriate communications and application forms are required to be completed and submitted to the U.S. Department of Justice in order to secure this federal funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the Mayor is hereby authorized to prepare, execute and submit the necessary application and supporting documentation on behalf of the City to secure the 2005 Local Law Enforcement Block Grant.

Local Law Enforcement Block Grant 2004

Since 1998 the City has chosen to use these funds to pay for a portion of the salary of "necessary support personnel" in the person of Computer Network Specialist. The Computer Network Specialist has developed computer programs that have cut down on duplication for police officers that enables them to get back out on patrol more quickly. The Computer Network Specialist has also been involved in several criminal investigations involving computer crimes and the Police Department has found this expertise to be extremely helpful. The Computer Network Specialist will continue to develop programs that improve the efficiency and effectiveness of our police officers and the police department as a whole. Grant monies in the amount of \$11,027 will be used to pay for the Police Department Computer Network Specialist Position.
