The following is a summary of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service during the month of February.

Incident reports:

Case # 13-001857, 03/02/2013, at 0222 hrs – 9442 W. National Av., Brooklyn.

On 03/02/2013 at 0222 hrs., Officers responded to Brooklyn, 9442 W. National Av. (Owner, Dominic LaLicata called and reported incident to police) for a Trouble Call, regarding a female causing a disturbance at the bar. Officers spoke with the owner, Dominc LaLicata, who stated an employee, Milarix Malave, was causing a disturbance. LaLicata stated he sent Malave home early because she fell asleep on stage and appeared intoxicated. As they were escorting Malave out of the bar, she began creating a disturbance, hit several bouncers and the owner in the face and groin. Malave left the scene prior to Officers arrival. As the Officers were speaking to LaLicata, Malave drove on scene. Malave appeared highly intoxicated and was subsequently arrested for OWI. Upon searching Malave, Officers located approximately 38 pills in a gold key chain pill container. While in booking Malave became extremely uncooperative and resistive. She was arrested for Controlled Substance, Disorderly Conduct, Resisting and OWI.
