The following is a summary of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service during the month of May, 2022;

INCIDENT REPORTS:

CASE #22-016677 – 05/14/22 – 1300hrs. – Aris Sports Bar – 1657 S. 108 St.

Officer Hartmann Reports:

On 05/14/22 at 1300hrs, officers responded to Aris Sports Bar (1657 S 108 St) regarding the check on the welfare of a [REDACTED] PNB subject. On scene WAFD Rescue provided CPR efforts and subsequent transport to Froedtert Hospital to the patient, Debra J Dejno [REDACTED]. At Froedtert Hospital, Dejno admitted to ingesting a substance that she believed to be cocaine while working as a server at the tavern. Officers subsequently recovered a folded piece of paper with a white powdery/crystalized substance and snorting straw from Dejno's work apron. Dejno is ordered into the West Allis Police Department for Booking for this incident for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia on 05/19/22 at 0700hrs. Investigation is on-going at this time.

On 05/14/2022 at 2137hrs. I responded to Bug N Out, 5630 W Lincoln Ave, for the report of a large group of people fighting. Upon arrival, contact was made with Carl Gust [REDACTED] and Judith S Scholtens [REDACTED]. Both subjects stated they were punched several times while in their vehicle by an unknown black female and unknown black male which caused them pain. There are no suspects at this time.

Officer Maxwell Reports:

On 05/24/22 at approximately 2056hrs, officers responded to Dhillon Beer & Liquor, 5832 W. Burnham St., regarding a hysterical female reporting an individual throwing things at a liquor store. Upon arrival, contact was made with the highly agitated caller and liquor store employee Samantha L. Grabowski [REDACTED]. Samantha advised a F/B, approx. 25 year old, shorter, stocky build wearing a light blue robe became upset when Samantha refused to complete a sale when the female did not have enough money. Samantha acknowledged arguing with the female who then threw some items from the front counter over the partition before leaving in an unknown direction.
