Dear Common Council Members:

I am notifying you of the formation of a task force to find and recommend to the Common Council suitable and appropriate sites for a police satellite facility on the East Side of the community. The Police & Fire Commission has authorized the formation of this group, and members of the Police Satellite Station Task Force are listed on the attached sheet.

Council President Murphy's December 17, 2002 letter (attached) to Police & Fire Commission President Clark outlined the issue of the inclusion of the police satellite station in the new fire administration building and that a substantial number of Council members have reservations about a separate facility. It was his suggestion that this Task Force be assembled to study the issue of a satellite facility.

Based on his recommendation and assistance, the additional persons (beyond City staff, Council and Commission representation) that will comprise the Task Force include East Side citizen and business representatives.

Dear President Clark:

The Administration and Finance and Public Works Committees of the Common Council met on December 9, 2002 to discuss the issue of the inclusion of the police satellite station in the new fire administration building. It is clear that a substantial number of Council members support the inclusion of that station as part of the remodeling of existing station No. 1. However, the city attorney has advised that Council that the issue of the location of the satellite station is entirely the province of the Commission. Under the optional powers granted to the Commission under state law, the Commission controls the day to day operations of the police and fire departments. The Common Council lacks authority in this area. Accordingly, the planning for the remodeling of existing station No. 1 into the fire administration facility may proceed without the inclusion of the satellite station, as such is the decision and prerogative of the Commission.

However, it is important to note that a significant number of Common Council members have serious reservations about building and/or maintaining a separate police satellite station facility. The Commission would need council approval to construct a facility. Likewise, any development proposal which would contain a facility would also need Council approval. That approval may not be easy to obtain.

It is my understanding the police chief does not view the existing satellite station as a long term solution to the perceived need on the east end of West Allis. It is further my understanding that the

long term need will not be met in the immediate future. Therefore, it is my recommendation, notwithstanding the first paragraph of this letter, that the Commission and the chiefs of the police and fire departments try to find some common ground which would allow the police department to have some degree of access to the new fire administration building, pending a permanent answer to the satellite station location question. This may alleviate some of the shortcomings of the current satellite facility. In addition, I suggest that a new committee be formed to study where a satellite facility might be located and how it would be paid for and maintained. It is my impression that the Common Council is of the opinion that levy dollars would not be used to construct any new facility. It would be prudent to include at least one member of the Common Council in the process. In addition to the obvious choices for membership of the committee, perhaps several block watch captains from the east side of the city could be considered for involvement. Several business representatives would also seem logical choices.

I would be pleased to meet with the Commission to help with the development of the process.
