DISPATCH TO CALL/ARRIVAL ON SCENE

On 9/18/14 at 0058hrs officers responded to Dopp's, 1753 S 68 St for a report of several intoxicated parties that left the bar and were attempting to kick the door in. I arrived on scene and began to speak with the caller,

STATEMENT OF COMPLAINANT

I arrived on scene at the business and began to speak with the caller, Susan Heim. Heim stated she observed a female and two males enter the business and sit at the end of the bar. Heim stated she observed the female, whom she heard the

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males call her "Katie", was unsteady while attempting to sit on a bar stool. Heim stated she asked "Katie" for identification but later told her she was unable to serve her based upon how intoxicated she was.

Heim stated within a few minutes, she observed the two males had placed two small glasses on the bar. Heim stated the specific glasses they had were not used at their bar and must have come from a separate business. Heim stated the two males began to argue with other patrons inside of the business. Heim stated they advised the two males and "Katie" to leave the business as they were attempting to start fights with other patrons. Heim stated they exited the business and locked the door. At this point I overheard Officer Kaye advise he was attempting to stop two uncooperative individuals on S 68 St in the 2000 BLK. I exited the business and responded to that location.

RESISTIVE EPISODE

I arrived on scene as Officer Kaye had detained one male and placed him on the sidewalk. Officer Kaye's squad's emergency lights were activated and faced towards the east sidewalk. A female was walking S/B on S 68 St away from squads as I arrived. I observed Officer Kaye approaching the female. I observed the female pull away from Officer Kaye.

I grabbed the female's left arm and escorted her to the ground. She was later identified as Katie Petersen. While on the ground, Petersen refused to place her hands behind her back. I yelled and instructed Petersen to place her hands behind her back and she refused. I reached under Petersen's body and forcefully had to remove her arms from under her and place them behind her back.

I attempted to speak with Petersen while she was still seated on the ground. Petersen refused to say anything and refused to identify herself. Petersen observed her friend, Antonio Johnson, was speaking with Officer Kaye. Petersen immediately began to scream "Tony! Don't fucking say anything!" Petersen refused to answer any questions. Petersen continued to scream at Johnson even after I placed her in the back of my squad.

While within close proximity of Petersen I detected a strong odor of intoxicants emitting from her breath. Petersen was slurring her speech and had red, glassy eyes.

CONTACT WITH PROBATION/PAROLE

I made contact with Probation/Parole and advised them of the incident regarding Petersen being intoxicated and resisting officers. They advised they would be placing a hold on Petersen.

IN CUSTODY INTERVIEW

On 9/18/14 at 0212hrs in Interview Room A, I read Petersen her Miranda Rights from WAPD Directive 42.016. In response to waiver questions, Petersen stated she understood her rights and refused to speak with me at the time.

The interview concluded at 0213hrs. The interview was recorded using WAPD Olympus Digital Voice Recorder. I placed the memory card in an envelope and secured it in the ID Bureau drawer.

CASE DISPOSITION

Petersen was later transported to CJF. She was given a local court date of 10/13/14 at 0830hrs.

NARRATIVE

PO Kaye Reports:

On 09/18/14 at approximately 0058hrs, officers responded to Dopp's, 1753 S 68 St, for a report of two males and one female in their mid 20's who were fighting, left the bar, and were attempting to kick the door in. The caller stated one male left the area, and the female (whose name was "Katie") and other male walked southbound on S 68 St. PO Foy went to Dopp's to speak with the caller while I checked the area.

LOCATING ANTONIO K. JOHNSON & KATIE E. PETERSEN

While checking the area I observed a male and female who appeared to be in their mid 20's, later identified as Antonio Kim Johnson (M/W 11/27/84) and Katie E. Petersen (F/W 12/15/84), walking southbound on the east sidewalk in front of 2040 S 68 St. I went to make contact with Antonio and Katie. I parked my squad angling the headlights at Antonio and Katie, activated my overhead emergency lights, and shinned my spot light at them. I exited my squad car and told Antonio and Katie to "Stop!"

Upon telling Antonio and Katie to "Stop!" Antonio stopped walking and faced me, whereas Katie stopped momentarily, faced me, then proceeded to turn her back to me. Katie disregarding my command and continued to walk away from me. I yelled for Katie to "Stop!" several more times before she eventually stopped walking approximately 20 feet from where Antonio had stopped when I first ordered them to stop. I walked up to Antonio, detained him, and sat him on the curb. While I was detaining Antonio I told Katie to stay where she was. After Antonio was seated on the curb I walked over to Katie.

RESISTIVE EPISODE

Katie was carrying a purse with both hands in front of her with a black jacket draped over both of her hands and her purse. I was unable to see either of Katie's hands. I grabbed Katie's right elbow and wrist as I was going to place her arms behind her back and detain her. Upon grabbing Katie's right arm, I immediately noticed resistive tension in Katie's arm. PO Foy arrived on scene around this time.

Katie resisted my efforts to place her right arm behind her back, moving in a clockwise circle as I moved her arm from under her jacket to the small of her back. When I grabbed Katie's arm she immediately started yelling and screaming. As Katie moved in a circle she attempted to pull away from me. At this point I had grabbed my handcuffs and was attempting to place them on Katie's right wrist. When Katie jerked her body away from me, it caused my

handcuffs to get knocked to the ground. Katie was escorted to the ground by PO Foy and I where PO Foy placed his handcuffs on Katie.

Katie was removed from the ground and placed in PO Foy's squad car. While Katie was in the squad car she was yelling and screaming uncontrollably. Katie was later transported to the WAPD for booking by PO Foy.

ON SCENE STATEMENT - ANTONIO K. JOHNSON

Antonio explained he was at Dopp's with Katie. Antonio stated he knew the owner "Tammy." Antonio stated he did not know why there was an argument at Dopp's. Antonio told me Katie was the one who was kicking/hitting the door at Dopp's after "Tammy" locked it. Antonio said he did not kick the door at all. Antonio was given a courtesy ride to his residence.

Cpl. McNally reports...

ARRIVAL

On 09-18-14 at approximately 0113 hrs, I responded to Dopp's, 1753 S. 68 St, to assist Officer Kaye and Officer Foy. They were out with a few uncooperative subjects and were unable to respond to the tavern to speak with the complainant. On arrival, I made contact with bartender/complainant, Susan J. Heim, who provided the following statement.

STATEMENT - SUSAN J. HEIM (bartender/complainant)

Heim stated a white female entered the tavern approximately five minutes prior to the call time. Heim checked the female's identification and recalled her first name was Katie and that she was born in 1989. Heim stated two highly intoxicated white males entered the tavern shortly thereafter. Heim refused service to both intoxicated males and asked them to leave the tavern. That's when both males started arguing with one another.

Heim stated she escorted the males out of the tavern with the help of other bar patrons. The female also left with males. Heim locked the front door of the tavern once all three subjects were outside. The three subjects refused to leave the area and Heim heard loud pounding on the front door. That's when Heim called the Police Department requesting officers to respond to the tavern.

Heim did not want the subjects arrested, but she did not want them causing problems outside of the business either. Heim requested the subjects be sent on their way.
