RESOLUTION AMENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CONRAD GARDENS NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, resolution R-2023-0499 adopted procedures to formalize the recognition of neighborhood associations and their boundaries. Conrad Gardens is an existing Neighborhood Association that seeks to reestablish its boundaries.

WHEREAS, the Common Council under Resolution Number R-2022-0332, approved the organizational establishment of Conrad Gardens Neighborhood Association and their defined boundaries; and,

WHEREAS, Conrad Gardens Neighborhood Association is requesting to shift their western border (currently the railroad tracks at approximately 105th Street) further east to end at HWY 41 (approximately 99th Street). An updated boundary map reflecting the neighborhood association's new operational service area is provided in Exhibit A.

WHEREAS, with the adoption of this resolution no other neighborhood association will be impacted, and no objection to the amended boundaries has been received.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the Conrad Gardens Neighborhood Association boundaries are amended as authorized in accordance with the City of West Allis establishment of neighborhood associations policy No. 3202 (5) approved under R-2023-0499.
